NOTICE OF ESTABLISHMENT OF NEW VOTING PRECINCT

To the Voters in the territory herein and hereafter described:

You are hereby notified that the County Board of Elections has created a new voting precinct to be known as GASTONIA, Number 4, and that all voters in said hereinafter described territory will vote or cast their ballots in the future at the said polling place which will be located at the COURT HOUSE, in the city of Gastonia, North Carolina.

The said territory of the said voting precinct, to be known as Gastonia, Number 4, is described as follows:

"Beginning at the present Northwest corner of Gastonia precinct No. 1, and runs with the present western boundary of Gastonia precinct No. 1, South to the present Southwest corner of Gastonia precinct No. 1; thence with the present southern boundary of Gastonia precinct No. 1, East to the C. & N. W. Railroad; thence with said C. & N. W. Railroad, in a Northerly direction to a point directly in the center of the C. & N. W. Railroad trestle, where said railroad crosses Catawba creek, just south of the city limits of the city of Gastonia; thence a straight line, in a Northerly direction to the center of the present terminus of South Street or South Street extension in the city of Gastonia; thence with the center of South Street, or South Street extension, and South Street, North to the center of Airline Avenue, where South Street runs into it on the North side of the Southern Railroad; thence with the center of Airline Avenue, West to the center of Dallas Street where it runs into Airline Avenue; thence with the center of Dallas Street North, to the center of Page Avenue where Dallas Street runs into it; thence with the center of Page Avenue, West to the center of North York Street where Page Avenue runs into it; thence with the center of North York Street North to the Northern terminus of North York Street; thence a straight line North to the present boundary line of Gastonia precinct No. 1; north of the city limits of Gastonia; thence with the present boundary line of Gastonia precinct No. 1, from said point following said present boundary line, northerly or westerly and west to the point of beginning.

That when the term present boundary, or present corner of, or present boundary line of Gastonia precinct No. 1, is used in the above description, it is intended to mean, the boundary of, or corner of, or boundary line of Gastonia precinct No. 1, as the same were immediately prior to the establishment of this precinct.

Notice is also given, that all voters residing within the territory embraced within said precinct known as Gastonia No. 4, will all have to register for the coming election, a complete, new registration being hereby ordered for said Gastonia precinct No. 4.

NEGROES WOULD TAKE PLACE OF ASIATICS IN CALIFORNIA
(By The Associated Press.)
LOS ANGELES, Calif., Sept. 28.—The possibility of negroes taking the place of Asiatics as farm workers in California was discussed today at the national convention of the Industrial and Commercial

Council of the People of African Descent. W. H. Sanders, a Los Angeles delegate, said he was in direct touch with at least 5,000 negroes who will come to California to take up truck gardening in case persons of Oriental races are barred from further colonization in this state. He said the workmen would be headed by graduates

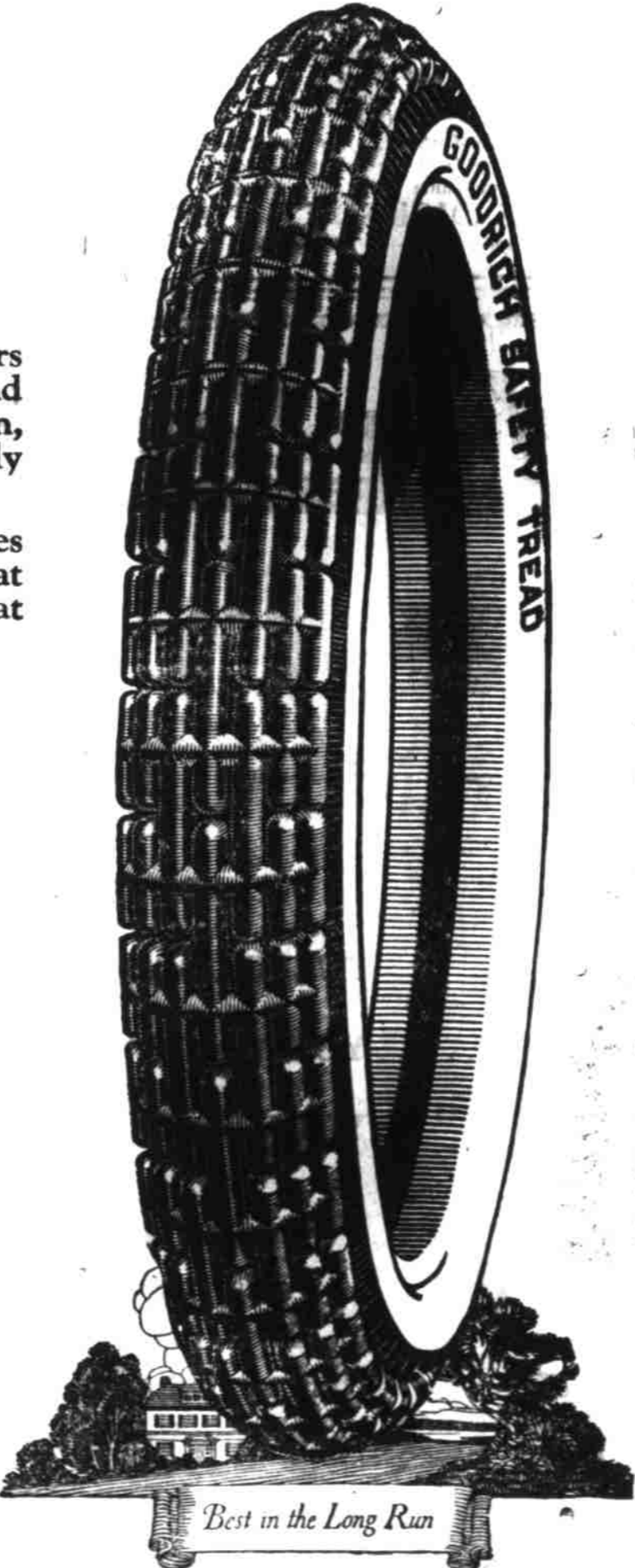
