EBERBACH, Baden, Germany, Feb. 2. -Grover Bergdoll has returned to Eberbach and has given your correspondent the first complete account of the negotiations that preceded his escape from his two guards at his home in Philadelphia L .: May,

"After my arrest last January," said Bergdoll, ~1 paid Charence Giblioney #11,000. That was for his services in connection with the court martial. I wanted to be let off with a light sentime and was well satisfied with the verdict of five years, for 1 had expected a much more severe one.
