## NOTED TENOR DESPERATELY ILL FROM HEART ATTACK

**Sacrament of Extreme Unction Administered at 1:25 O'Clock This Morning — Had Suffered From Attack of Pleurisy.**

NEW YORK, Feb. 16.—Oxygen today was being administered to Enrico Caruso, world famous tenor, who is waging a fight against death after last night having been stricken with a heart attack that caused his physician to fear he would succumb before dawn.

Shortly before 11 o'clock more oxygen tanks were taken to the singer's apartments in the Hotel Vanderbilt, where the tenor is lying surrounded by relatives and comrades in the Metropolitan Opera Company. A consultation of doctors has been called.

Shortly after 8:30 o'clock this morning it was announced at Caruso's apartment that he was "holding his own." He had rallied considerably, it was said, but his condition was still very serious.

NEW YORK, Feb. 16.—The condition of Enrico Caruso, tenor, who suffered a grave heart attack late last night, was reported to be slightly improved early this day. Attending physicians admitted, however, that the famous singer was "desperately ill." He had been improving steadily from a severe attack of pleurisy and his relapse was evidently unexpected.

The sacrament of extreme unction was administered to him at 1:25 o'clock this morning by Rev. E. E. Molinelli of the Church of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Caruso, at intervals throughout the night and early morning hours lapsed into semi-consciousness, but rallied slightly after ministrations of oxygen and tracheal stimulants.

Fully aware of his condition, Caruso directed the sending of a telegram to his son, Enrico, Jr., who is a student at Culver Military Academy, Culver, Ind. He then expressed to his wife his desire to see his friends and all the singers with whom he had been associated in the Metropolitan Opera Company, to tell them "goodbye."

Antonio Scotti, and his colleague M. Fucito, appeared early this morning to visit the tenor in his apartment in the Vanderbilt hotel and remained several hours. They were joined by Orville Harrold, Phoenix Eastman, and others, members of the opera company, who returned late from Philadelphia, where they played last night. All were deeply affected. They reported Caruso in a cheerful mood.

Caruso was first struck sick in December, while singing in the Brooklyn Academy of Music. Despite a temporary blood vessel in his throat, he sang not until his audience learned of the accident and protested against his absence.

He was compelled, as a result of the occurrence, to cancel a previous engagement at the New York City Hall on Christmas eve, singing "La Juive." His voice, however, failed to recover. The audience at the Metopolitan that night was the most brilliant of the season, and the "Golden Voice" received a standing ovation. That was Caruso's last public appearance.

Two days later he suffered an attack of pleurisy. This later became complicated, necessitating two operations. The result showed marked improvement in several weeks later, so well, that he entered his apartment "that he was world-famous again," notes; his voice was unimpaired and expected to be able to return to the stage soon.
