TRAVELING MEN PROTEST AGAINST HOTEL RATES. OMAHA, NEB., Feb. 18. — Letters have been sent to the 600,000 commercial travelers urging them to institute a 30 day strike against hotels that charge what the organization terms exorbitant prices for room and food.

The letters have been sent out by the Hotel Committee of the International Federation of Commercial Travelers Organizations and says in part: "Traveling men all over the country have reached the conclusion that the prices charged by hotels for rooms and meals have reached the peak."

A thirty days' strike along the line has been suggested will cause the hotels to make more favorable terms and arrangements.
