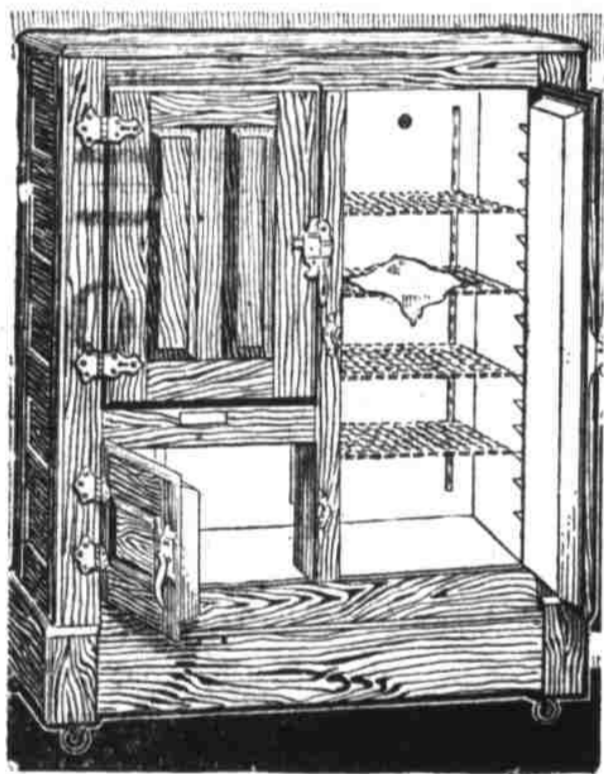

COTTON MILL STRIKE IN COLUMBUS IS BROKEN

COLUMBUS, Ga., March 31. With the return to work of forty operatives, the walkout of several hundred textile workers of the Eagle and Phoenix mills which occurred yesterday morning, when the company refused to grant the demand of the workers for a 30 per cent increase in wages and more working hours, appeared to be broken.

The return of the employees was greeted by the superintendent of the plant without comment, and they were given back their old positions. According to an announcement made this morning by a mill official none of the operatives are expected to return within the next few days, as they realize now that the company cannot meet their demands on account of the low cotton market and the slack demand for heavy colored goods such as is manufactured at this plant.

TRIS SPEAKER WILL DISCOURAGE GAMBLING

## ENTIRELY IN HANDS OF FEDERAL OFFICERS.

(By The Associated Press.)

LANSING, Mich., March 31. — Enforcement of the prohibition laws in Michigan was entirely in the hands of federal officers today and "dry" leaders in the legislature, together with Governor Groesbeck and Attorney General Wiley, were framing a new state "dry" law to replace the Wiley act, which was virtually annulled by a supreme court decision here yesterday.

The effect of the supreme court's ruling, in the opinion of officials here, was to declare unconstitutional the search and seizure provision of the Wiley act, by reversing a circuit court case in which a defendant was convicted of illegally transporting liquor into the state. The high court held that to prevent interstate traffic in liquor was a duty of federal officers and that such cases could not be taken under jurisdiction by state authorities.

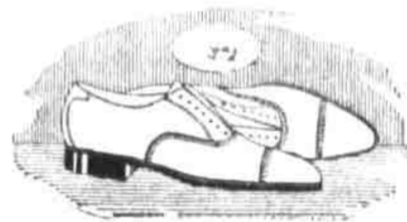
