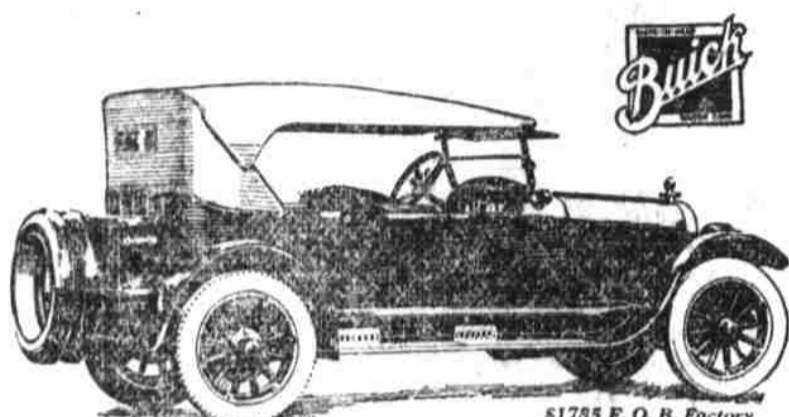
LUSITANIA CARRIED VERY LITTLE GOLD

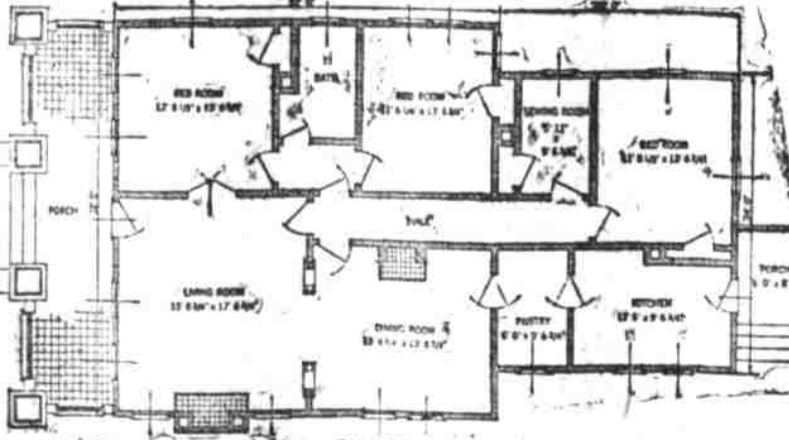
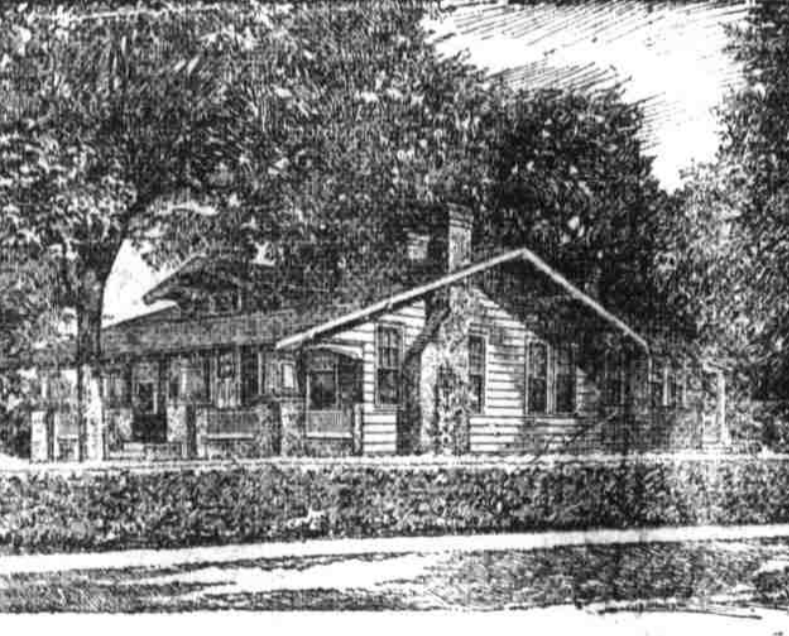

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF \$10,000.00 OF BONDS OF THE TOWN OF BESSEMER CITY, NORTH CAROLINA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF ERECTING A MUNICIPAL BUILDING.

Be it ordained by the Board of Town Commissioners of the Town of Bessemer City in Gaston County, North Carolina, as follows: Section 1. Pursuant to 'The Municipal Finance Act, 1921' of North Carolina, bonds of the Town of Bessemer City are hereby authorized to be issued in the aggregate principal amount of not exceeding \$10,000.00, for the purpose of the erection and equipment of a municipal building for said Town of Bessemer City, and at the expense of the Town at large.

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE ISSUANCE OF \$8,000.00 OF BONDS OF THE TOWN OF BESSEMER CITY, NORTH CAROLINA, FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXTENDING THE WATER SYSTEM OF SAID TOWN.

Be it ordained by the Board of Town Commissioners of the Town of Bessemer City in Gaston County, North Carolina, as follows: Section 1.
