The election for president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer of the associa tion, manager and sub-managers o the baseball team, manager of the track team, and all other officers of the Association shall be held on the first Saturday in May. But these o ficers, with the exception of the mana icers, whemaners of the differ until the following year.
Sec. 6. The president of the Asso ciation shall advertise the election of officers at least forty-eight hours bc fore hand, in the manner prescribe for advertising other meetings.
Sec. 7. The management of the Association's business shall be intrustAssociation's to the following officers and committees: president, vice-president, se retary, treasurer, manager and at leas two sub-managers of the football tean manager and at least two sub-man: gers of the baseball team, manager o the track team; committee on finance committee on recommendations, com mittee on rules and regula tions, committee for the awarding o sweaters, and such special committee: as may be appointed by the presiden of the assoctation tor the transach of particular business.
Article 5 -Duties of Officers and Committees.
Sec. 1. President. (a) No person shall be el،gible for president of the Association until he shall have lived at this University for a period of thret years. (b) The president shall ca and preside over all meetings of $t 1$ Association; shall decide all questior of order; shall vote in case of a tie, bu not otherwise; and shall appoint a committees whose appointment is no committees whose appo
otherwise provided
Sec. 2. Vice President (a) No men Sec. 2. Vice President (a) No men
ber shall be eligible for the office o Vice President who is not eligible fo the office of President. The vice-pre: ident shall perform all the duties of the president in the absence or ince pacity of the president.

Sec. 3. (a) The secretary shall be chosen from the senior class. (b) It shall be his duty to keep a record of all the proceedings of the association. He shall keep also a roll of members and shall have it together with the minute book at all meetings duly called. He shall also obtain from the treasurer, and keep as a record, the names of all members who have been names of all members who have been
disfranchised for the non-pajment of dues.
Sec. 4. Treesurer. (a) The treasurer shall be chosen from the senior class (b). He shall have charge of the gensral treasury of the athletic association.

He shall convey all moneys into the treasury; and on the written order of the chairman of the finance committee, acting for the Commitiee, shall disburse the same. (c). It shall be his duty to collect all fees due to the Association, and to keep a record of the same. He shall have authority to expend such sums as may be necessary for the purchase of stationery for the Association. (d). He shall receive fifty dollars for his services. (e). The Treasurer, before entering upon his duties shall give a bond, the amount of which shall be fixed by the Finance Committee, and the bond must also be approved by the Committee. The Association shall pay all fees necessary for the procurement of the Treasurer's bond.
Sec. 5. Managers of teams. (a). No person shall be eligible to the office of Manager of the football team or baseball team who has not served at leas one term as sub-manager. (b). It each team to prepare a schedule of yames for his team; to make suitable provision for the comfort of his teams while on its trips; to arrange for the accomodation of visiting teams; to accomodation of visiting teams; to
provide for the clothing of his team; and to hold in trust all moneys which may come into his hands; and he shal have authority to expend such sums as may be necessary to meet the obligations incurred by his team. (c). At the end of the season each managet shall turn over to the Treasurer of thi Association all the money in his ands, and shall make an itemized statemerit of all his transactions to the Finance Committee. (d). At least wo sub-managers and if necessary more shall be elected by the Association to assist the managers of the football and baseball teams. (e). The ub-managers shall be chosen from the Junior and Sophomore classes.

## Sec. 6-Finance Committee.

(A). This Committee shall be composed of five members, two, and only wo, of which shall be members of the faculty. The members of this Com mittee shall be appointed by the President of the Association, acting by and with the advice of the Vice-President and Secretary. It shall be the duty of his Committee to hear all claims gainst the Association; and to make all orders on the Treasurer for the pay ment of moneys.
(B) It shall be the duty of the Fi ance Committee to employ coaches or the various teams.
(C) This Committee shall inspect he books of the Treasurer and the various Managers at the end of the season, and shall make a report to the Association at the end of each term. It shall have authority also to inspect
the books of any officer at apy time.

Sec. 7-Committee on Rules and Regulations
(A) This Committee shall be composed of five members, three of whom shall be members of the faculty appointed by the President of the University; and two of whom shall be student members of the Association.
(B) It shall be the duty of this Com nittee to make rules to govern athltics, to determine the elegibility of men desiring to play on the team and o represent the Association in disputes with other colleges as to rules and eligibility of players.
Sec. 8-Committee on Recommendation. (A) This Committee shall be con posed of the Finance Committee, the members of the Committee on Rules and Regulations, the President, VicePresident, the Secretary, and the Trea urer of the Association, the Manager of the Football, Baseball, and Track teams, Editor-in-chief of the Tar Heel and the director of out-door athletics. (B) This Committee shall meet on the fourth Saturday of each month and at such times as the chairman shall call it together
(C) The Chairman of the Committee on Rules and Regulations shall be exofficio Cla rman of this Committee.
(D) It shall be the duty of this Committee to consider the general business of the Association, and to make such recommendations to the Association, and to its officers anc Committees as may seem to it exped tent; but this Committee shall hav no powers other than of recommendation. It shall advise the Association ut shall not act for the Association. Sec. 9-Committee for Awarding Sweaters.
(A) A Committee for awarding weaters shall be appointed for each of the teams. Eeach Committee shal consist of the Captain, Manager, and Coach of the paiticular team and two additional members to be appointed by the President of the Association; one of whom shall be a student and the other a member of the faculty. (B) Each of these committees skal at the end of the athletic seasun se lect such men as have by their athelt ic attainments shown themselves worthy of sweaters; and shall report t the last meeting of the Association the number of sweaters and to whom given on the different teams.

Article 6-Amendments

But each amendment must be submitted in writing, read before the Athletic Association, and allowed to lie on the table one week before it shall become a part of this constitution.
