Detailed account:

N. C. kicks to W. & L's. 14 yard line. Wilson recieves ball and returns it 10 yards. W. & L. makes no gain on first down. On second down W. & L. fumbles and Hedgepeth gets the ball. First down, no gain. Second down, N. C. gains 2 yards. On an attempted foward pass N. C. loses ground, and the ball goes over. O'Quinn punts 20 yards to N. C. N. C. gains 10 yards around left end. Second down, no gain. N. C. makes first down. W. & L. is penalized 5 yards for off side play. N. C. gains 7 yards on fake end run. First down on W. & L's. 20 yard line. N. C. makes no gain on first down. Osborne is off side and W. & L. is penalized 5 yards. Second down, N. C. makes first down. N. C. no gain thru the line. N. C. attempts drop kick from 5 yard line but fails. W. & L's. ball on their 25 yard line. O'Quinn kicks out of bounds. N. C's. ball on W. & L's. 35 yard line. N. C. makes 10 yards on a forward pass. First down, no gain. Second down, N. C. goes 5 yards thru line. N. C. fails to make the required 10 yards, and the ball goes over. O'Quinn kicks 35 yards to N. C. N. C's. ball on their 45 yard line. Time out. W. & L. man hurt. He resumes play. N. C. kicks to W. & L's. 20 yard line. The ball is returned 15 yards. First down, no gain for W. & L. On second down W. & L. fumbles, and Winston gets the ball. Carolina gains 4 yards thru the line. Time out. W. & L. man hurt. He resumes play. N. C. makes first down. N. C. makes 6 yards. N. C. no gain. N. C. gains 15 yards on forward pass. N. C. goes 1 yard. N. C. looses one yard. N. C. attempts drop kick from 15 yard line but fails. Brown of W. & L. hurt. Goes back in game. W. & L's. ball on their 10 yard line. First down W. & L. gains 2 yards. O'Quinn kicks short kick and Carolina recovers on W. L's. 25 yard line. N. C. looses 4 yards. N. C. punts to Waddell who returns 15 yards. Time out for N. C. man. Resumes play. W. & L's. ball on their 25 yard line. Wilson gains 5 yards on end run. W. & L. is penalized 15 yards for holding. Time out. W. & L. man hurt. O'Quinn punts 40 yards to N. C. who receives ball in center of field. N. C. kicks long punt, Venable gets down after it, secures pigskin and scores only touchdown of the game. Belden kicks goal.

W. & L. kicks to N. C. who returns 15 yards. N. C. kicks out of bounds. W. & L's. ball in center of field. First down W. & L. goes 2 yards over tackle. No gain on second down. Waddell punts on side kick and Carolina gets the ball on their 30 yard line. N. C. kicks. Waddell fumbles, and Carolina recovers in midfield. First down, N. C. gains 1 yard. Second down, no gain. N. C. makes on side kick for 20 yards carrying ball to W. & L's. 30 yard line. Burkes throws N. C. for a ten yard loss. N. C. pen-

alized 10 yards for off side. Time up for first half. Score N. C. 6 W. & L. 0.

SECOND HALF.

W. & L. kicks off to Belden who tears thru the scattered field for 25 yards. N. C. punts out of bounds. W. & L's. ball on their 45 yards line. W. & L. gains 2 yds. Waddell kicks short kick and Belk receives ball and returns it to W. & L's. 45 yard line. Belk kicks out of bounds. W. & L's. ball. On first down W. & L. fumbles and Deans falls on the ball. Carolina penalized 5 yards for off side play. Crowell kicks to Hutcheson. Hutcheson fails to gain. W. & L. tries forward pass, but "Bob" Winston receives the ball and speeds it to W. & L's. 20 yard line. Carolina attempts forward pass, Waddell recieves, but is downed by quarterback Belk. Time out. Waddell hurt. He resumes play. W. & L. makes her 8 yards on a fake. W. & L. attempts forward pass, Belden receives it. N. C. looses 1 yd. Crowell tries on side kick but W. & L. gets the ball. First down gains 5 yards. Second down adds 1 yard. W. & L. kicks 35 yards, and N. C. receives ball on her 40 yard line. Carolina punts, Waddell fumbles and "Dickie" Belden recovers. W. & L. penalized 5 yards for off side play. N. C. gains 6 yards thru the line. N. C. makes first down. N. C. attempts forward pass, but gets only the penalty. N. C. kicks to midfield, and Belden recovers the ball. Time out. Crowell hurt. He resumes play. Simms goes in Hutcheson's place. N. C. makes 4 yards around end. Crowell makes first down. Porter hits the line for a 15 yard gain. Capt. Izard takes Brown's place at right half. Brown injured, not seriously. N. C. makes no gain on first down. Crowell goes 5 yards thru center. Porter makes first down. First down with Carolina's ball on W. & L's. 10 yard line. N. C. gains 2 yards thru tackle. N. C. gains 5 yards around end. On third down N. C. loses the ball on W. & L's 1 yard line. W. & L. punts from behind the goal line. N. C's. ball on W. & L's. 35 yd. line. Belden tears a hole thru tackle for 4 yards. Porter adds 4 over guard. N. C. makes first down by carrying the ball to W. & L's 20 yard line. Tillet replaces Belk at quarter. Quigleby takes Morales place at guard. N. C. man hurt, time out. He resumes play. Crowell gains 2 yards. Porter makes 5. Crowell makes first down. No gain on first down. N. C. attempts forward pass, but Waddell gets the ball. Alderson makes W. & L's. first down by tearing thru center. N. C. man hurt. W. & L. gains 5 yards. W. & L. is forced to kick to midfield. Tillet returns ball 15 yards. W. & L. man hurt. N. C. kicks to W. & L. who returns 9 yards. On a forward pass Barnard gets away for 20 yards. W. & L. attempts another forward pass, but fails and 15 yards penalty is inflicted. Ball goes over. N. C's. ball on W. & L's. 20 yard line. W. & L. takes a brace and holds N. C. for downs the ball goes over on the 15 yard line. Time out. Simms resumes play but time is called. Score N. C. 6, W. & L. 0.

SCHOOL OF MEDICINE

Undergraduate Department. The One Hundred and Forty-fifth Session will begin September, 23 1910. The course of instruction, extending over four annual sessions of eight and one-half months each, is a carefully graded and eminently practical one, beginning with the fundamental branches with full laboratory exercises, proceeding through a comprehensive system of clinical instruction in which ward and bedside instruction and individual work on the part of the students form a large part, and terminating in the Fourth Year with the assignment of students as clinical clerks in the Hospital. A large proportion (more than 80 per cent.) of the graduating classes secure positions as internes in hospitals. Entrance requirements embrace a minimum of two years of college work, including two languages other than English (French or German must be one of these) and at least one year of study with appropriate laboratory work in Physics, General Biology or Zoology and General and Inorganic Chemistry (including Qualitative Analysis).
