Sec. 5. Elections. The election for the manager and sub-managers of the football team shall be held on the first Saturday in December. The election for president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer of the association, manager and sub-managers of the baseball team, manager of the track team, and all other officers of the association shall be held on the first Saturday in May. But these officers, with the exception of the managers and sub-managers of the different teams, shall not take their seats until the following year.
