Left guard—Dasheill (V. M. I.).

A steady player with plenty of experience.

Center—Bray (A. & M.).

Accurate in passing, fast under punts and strong on defense.

Right guard—Fitzgerald (Georgetown).

Has the weight and is a scrapper from start to finish.

Right tackle—Weymard (Georgetown).

The classiest tackle of the season. A fine punter.

Right end—Klutz (Davidson).

The best end in the half way of the South. Fast as a bat out of Hades and a peach with forward passes.

Quarter back—Costello (Georgetown).

Young but a splendid man in every respect. A fine drop kicker and open field runner.

Left half—Todd (Virginia).

Light but the best open field runner in this section.

Right half—Robertson (A. & M.).

Heavy and marvelously fast. An excellent line plunger.

Full back—Porter (Carolina).

Best defensive back on a South Atlantic gridiron this year. Probably the best line plunger.

That bunch would give any team in the country a good stiff fight.
