NEW CONSTITUTION FOR THE G. A. A.

and enforce the provisions of this constitution set forth in Ar icle Three, of which this section is a

Continued from First Page

Sec. 4. It shall be the duty of the President, and, in his absence, the Vice-President, to call a meeting of the Association whenever and in such manner as the Athletic Council may direct. All meetings of the Association shall be presided over by the President, and in the event of his absence, by the Vice-President All business shall be transacted in accordance with the rules of procedure in force in the National Congress, so far as they may appropriately pply, in the discretion of the presiding officer.

It shall be the duty of the Sec retary to keep as accurate and permanent record of all meetings of the Association, and he shall turn over to his successor a full and complete record of all business transacted by the Association, in meeting, during his term of office. It shall be his duty to keep an accurate and complete record of the names of all active members of the Association during his term of office.

It shall be the duty of the Sergeant-at-Arms to maintain proper order and decorum upon the part of members of the Association attendant upon Association meetings. He shall also perform such other duties as may be assigned to him by the President, Vice-President or Secretary of the Association

Sec. 5. All General Athletic Association officers, as hereinbefore provided for, and all student managers and assistant managers of the various Varsity teams, and a representative at large from the Associatio, shall be elected at a meeting of the Association held during the spring term of the University. Such officers, managers, assistant managers, and representative shall serve in the capacity in which elected during the next succeeding college year. The elections herein provided for shall be by ballot, in open meeting, in the following manner:


Proposals shall be received by the presiding officer of the name of any active member of the Association who is a candidate for election to the office on which vote is to be had. If more than two names are proposed f r any one office, all such names hall be voted on by pallot and the two names receiving the greatest number of votes shall constitute the nominees. In case two or more names receive an equal number of votes, and such names qualify e ally as nominees, all such n- es wall mominees. Upon determing he nominees a second ballot shall be cast and the nominee receiving the greater number of votes shall be elect d. If, however, two names or less are proposed, only one ball a shall he dart and the one receiving the majority of votes cast shall be elected. In case of a tie, as many ballots as may be necessary shall be taken until an election is had in accordance with the provisions

Sec 6. One student manager and two assistant managers shall be elected, as hereinbefore provided, for each of the four major branches of sport namely: Baseball, football, basket-ball and track. It shall be the duty of all managers and assistant managers to report to the graduate manager and they shall perform such duties as he may assign them.

ARTICLE FOUR

Sec. 1. This constitution shall, if so desired by the general athletic association, be amended in such respect and in such manner vided It shall, however require a two-thirds vote of all active members to change, alter or amend any of the provisions here-
