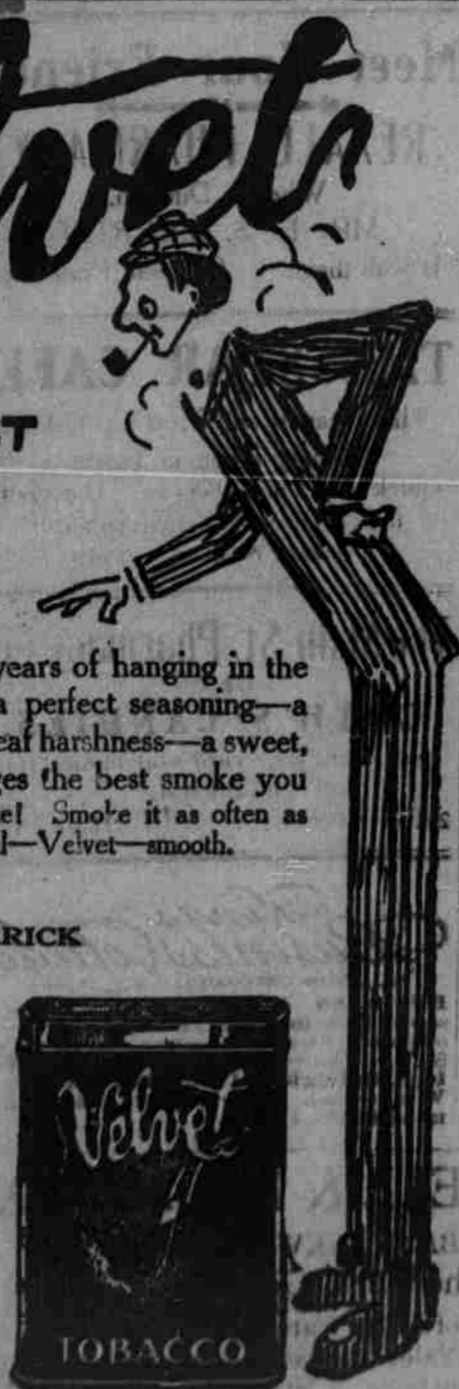

NEW CONSTITUTION FOR THE C. A. A.

Continued from First Page.

and enforce the provisions of this
constitution set forth in Article
Three, of which this section is a
part.

Sec. 4. It shall be the duty of
the President, and, in his ab-
sence, the Vice-President, to call
a meeting of the Association
whenever and in such manner as
the Athletic Council may direct.
All meetings of the Association
shall be presided over by the
President, and, in the event of
his absence, by the Vice-Presi-
dent. All business shall be trans-
acted in accordance with the rules
of procedure in force in the Na-
tional Congress, so far as they
may appropriately apply, in the
discretion of the presiding officer.

It shall be the duty of the Sec-
retary to keep an accurate and
permanent record of all meetings
of the Association, and he shall
turn over to his successor a full
and complete record of all busi-
ness transacted by the Associa-
tion, in meeting, during his term
of office. It shall be his duty to
keep an accurate and complete
record of the names of all active
members of the Association dur-
ing his term of office.

It shall be the duty of the Ser-
geant-at-Arms to maintain proper
order and decorum upon the part
of members of the Association
attendant upon Association meet-
ings. He shall also perform such
other duties as may be assigned
to him by the President, Vice-
President or Secretary of the
Association.

Sec. 5. All General Athletic
Association officers, as hereinbe-
fore provided for, and all student
managers and assistant managers
of the various Varsity teams, and
a representative at large from the
Association, shall be elected at a
meeting of the Association held
during the spring term of the
University. Such officers, man-
agers, assistant managers, and
representative shall serve in the
capacity in which elected during
the next succeeding college year.
The elections herein provided for
shall be by ballot, in open meet-
ing, in the following manner:

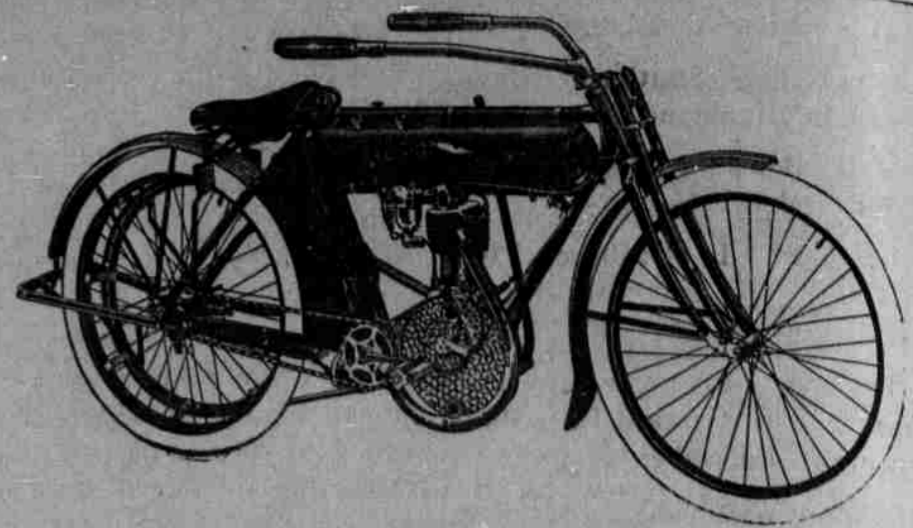
Proposals shall be received by
the presiding officer of the name
of any active member of the Asso-
ciation who is a candidate for
election to the office on which
vote is to be had. If more than
two names are proposed for any
one office, all such names shall be
voted on by ballot and the two
names receiving the greatest num-
ber of votes shall constitute the
nominees. In case two or more
names receive an equal number of
votes, and such names qualify
equally as nominees, all such
names shall be nominees. Upon
determining the nominees a sec-
ond ballot shall be cast and the
nominee receiving the greater
number of votes shall be elected.
If, however, two names or less
are proposed, only one ballot shall
be cast and the one receiving the
majority of votes cast shall be
elected. In case of a tie, as many
ballots as may be necessary shall
be taken until an election is had
in accordance with the provisions
herein.

Sec. 6. One student manager
and two assistant managers shall
be elected, as hereinbefore pro-
vided, for each of the four major
branches of sport namely: Base-
ball, football, basket-ball and
track. It shall be the duty of all
managers and assistant managers
to report to the graduate man-
ager and they shall perform such
duties as he may assign them.

ARTICLE FOUR

Sec. 1. This constitution shall,
if so desired by the general ath-
letic association, be amended in
such respect and in such manner
as may, in open meeting, be pro-
vided. It shall, however, require
a two-thirds vote of all active
members to change, alter or
amend any of the provisions here-
of.
