Field Adjoining Peabody Building To Be Turned Over to Dr. Coker

The field adjoining the grounds of the Peabody Building which was formerly in use by the Tomato Club girls the of Chapel Hill High School has been turned over to Dr. W. C. Coker, of the Botany department. Dr. Coker has done much to beautify the surroundings of the University by transforming the barren waste back of Davie Hall and the Chemistry Building into an Arboretum which is the pride of H-The Summer School. the college.

It is proposed to carry on similar work in the Peabody Field, which is now being laid off for purposes of cultivation and experimentation. Part of this field will be used for the cultivation of more than 250 North Carolina shrubs, part for the cultivation of foreign shrubs, and part for testing seeds and fertilizers, and making practical experiments with common crops.

This work will be particularly valuable to students of Education who are to teach in schools where agriculture and gardening form a part of the curriculum.
