Speed Violators Are to Receive Little Sympathy

As a result of the fatal accident Sunday evening, speed limit violators near Chapel Hill will receive little sympathy if apprehended, State Highway Patrolman Robert R. Thomas said yesterday.

"There was no evidence of drunken driving or mechanical trouble in Sunday night's wreck," Thomas said. "The sole cause, apparently, was speeding."

In an effort to end the violation of state speed limits the consideration usually extended student lawbreakers will be dropped, Thomas said. He pointed out that on the hilly roads approaching Chapel Hill even the allowed speeds can be dangerous.

The limit on Pittsboro road and Highway 54 toward Greensboro and toward Raleigh is 50 m.p.h. The limit on the Durham road is 40 m.p.h.




