## Talley To Assist Marine Recruiter

Walter R. Talley, of Bradenton, Fla., has been named by the Commandant of the Marine Corps to assist Captain Lawrence W. Smith, Jr., USMC, in the procurement of eligible students for the Marine Corps Platoon Leaders class.

Talley, a Sergeant in the Marine Corps Reserve (Inactive), last summer attended the advanced training for veteran students at Marine Corps School, Quantico, Va., and will receive a commission in the Marine Corps reserve as second lieutenant on graduation. He is in training for the six-week course offered for veterans with at least a year in the armed forces.

The Platoon Leaders class is open for eligible students of the freshman, sophomore, and junior class who enroll for the program. Talley and Captain Smith have the necessary data concerning the PLC program.

Talley resides at the ATO house, and Captain Smith has his office in the Naval armory on South Columbia street.
