izations receiving appropriations from the Government Board;

(6) To make all laws necessary and proper to promote the general welfare of the Summer School Student Body, except that in no case shall any act of the Summer School Government Board continue in force and effect beyond the termination of the summer school during which said act shall have been passed.

Section 4 (Judicial Councils):
(a) All judicial councils to be operative;

The judicial councils established in Article II Section 1 of this constitution shall be operative during summer school.

(b) (Powers):
The powers of the respective judicial councils shall be those set forth in Article II, Section 2 of this constitution.

(c) (Composition):
(1) (Summer School Student Council):
The Summer School Student Council shall be composed of the members of the Summer School Government Board.

(2) (Women's Council):
The Women's Council shall be composed of seven women students appointed by the President of the Student Body.

(3) (Men's Council):
The Men's Council shall be composed of seven men students appointed by the President of the Student Body.

(4) (Law School Court, Medical School Court, Men's Interdormitory Council Court, Women's House Councils, Interfraternity Council Court, and Dance Committee):
The Law School Court, Medical School Court, Men's Interdormitory Council Court, Women's House Councils, Interfraternity Council Court, and Dance Committee respectively shall provide for the continuation and operation of these judicial councils during summer school.

(d) (General procedure):
Article II, Section 4 of this Constitution shall continue in full force and effect during summer school.

Section 5 (Summer school orientation):
The Campus Orientation Committee shall devise and conduct an adequate program of orientation for all entering summer school students.

ARTICLE VIII (Powers of recall, initiative, referendum, constitutional guarantees):
Section 1 (Recall):
A constituency shall have power to recall any officer elected by that constituency under this constitution. If the constituency is campus-wide, the petition to recall shall be headed to the President of the Student Body and shall not be valid unless it contains the signatures of at least ten per cent of the qualified voters. If the constituency is less than campus-wide, the petition to recall shall not be valid unless it contains the signatures of at least twenty-five per cent of the qualified voters in the constituency concerned. The President shall have power to initiate any act within the limitations of this constitution, direct the Elections Board to conduct an election on the bill in not less than six nor more than fifteen days after he shall have received the petition and bill. Public notice of such election shall be given not less than four days before it shall take place. A majority of the votes cast at the election shall be sufficient to pass the bill.

Section 2 (Initiative):
The Student Body shall have power to initiate any act within the power of the Student Legislature, and the women students shall have power to initiate any act within the power of the Coed Senate, provided that ten per cent of the qualified voters in the group concerned shall sign a petition calling for an election within that group in writing with the petition to the President of the Student Body. The President shall, if he determines the petition to be in good order within the limitations of this constitution, direct the Elections Board to conduct an election on the bill in not less than six nor more than fifteen days after he shall have received the petition and bill. Public notice of such election shall be given not less than four days before it shall take place. A majority of the votes cast at the election shall be sufficient to pass the bill.

Section 3 (Referendum):
The Student Body shall have power to call for a ballot on any act of the Student Legislature and the women students shall have power to call for a ballot on any act of the Coed Senate. The petition calling for such an election shall be given not less than ten per cent of the group concerned and transmitted in writing to the President of the Student Body. The President shall, if he determines the petition to be in good order within the limitations of this constitution, direct the Elections Board to conduct an election on the act in not less than six nor more than fifteen days after he shall have received the petition. Public notice of such election shall be given not less than four days before it shall take place. A majority of the votes cast at the election shall be sufficient to pass the bill.

Section 4 (Coercion of voters prohibited):
No group or organization on the campus of the University shall coerce or in any manner unduly influence any student's vote. The Student Legislature shall have power to make laws to enforce this provision.

Section 5 (Guarantee of constitutional right and freedom):
Neither the Student Legislature nor the Coed Senate shall make any laws abridging or denying the freedom of the Student press or any other freedom guaranteed by the Constitution of the United States to citizens of the United States or by the Constitution of the State of North Carolina.

The incumbent shall continue in office until the election returns shall be officially announced.

Section 2 (Initiative):
The Student Body shall have power to initiate any act within the power of the Student Legislature, and the women students shall have power to initiate any act within the power of the Coed Senate, provided that ten per cent of the qualified voters in the group concerned shall sign a petition calling for an election within that group in writing with the petition to the President of the Student Body. The President shall, if he determines the petition to be in good order within the limitations of this constitution, direct the Elections Board to conduct an election on the bill in not less than six nor more than fifteen days after he shall have received the petition and bill.
