Basic training lasts 27 weeks and is taken by all students. The advanced phase of training varies in length depending on the specific course pursued, but all successful candidates are commissioned at the same time after approximately 52 of training. Graduates of this program may be assigned as crew members of bombardment, transport, reconnaissance, or interceptor type aircraft.

As to qualifications, applicants must be 20 to 261/2 years of age, and must have completed 2 years of college in an acredited institution. They must be single, and agree to remain so during the training period. Their physical standards are the same as for Aviation Cadet pilot training, except for less stringent visual requirements.
