Schedules have just been released by the Intramural Department for summer softball and tennis.

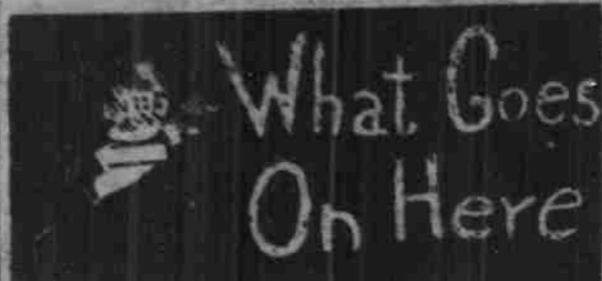
Completion dates for each tennis round are as follows:

He holds an M.A. degree from the New School of Social Research and a B.A. from Sacred Heart college in Chile. He is also a Ph.D. candidate in sociology here.
