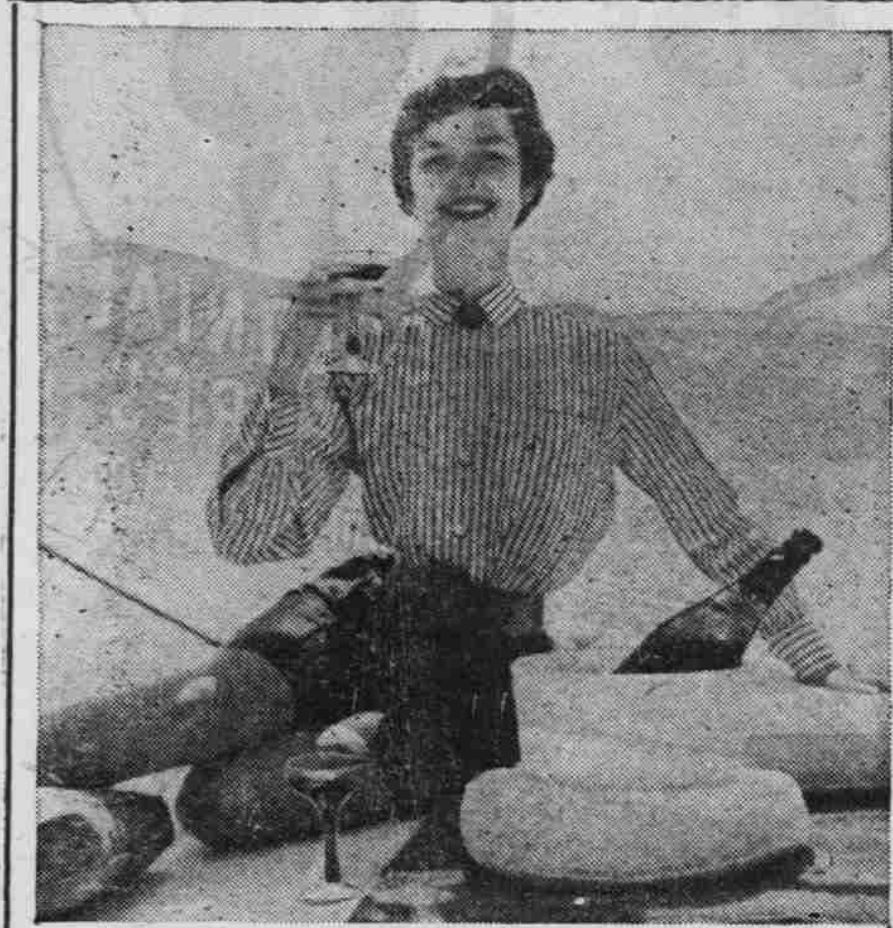
Episcopal Students
