United Church Schedules Yule Concert

A concert of Christmas music will be presented by the Sanctuary Choir and the Youth Choir at the United Congregational Christian Church Sunday at 7:30 p.m. Everyone has been invited.

There will be Christmas selections by Pergolesi, Berlioz, Bach, Handel, and several folk songs. The Youth Choir, directed by Mrs. Shiela Jameson, will sing carols from France, England, and Poland.

The climax of the service will be the presentation by the Sanctuary Choir of Clokey's cantata, "When the Christ Child Came", directed by William Sasser. Thelma Sasser is Organist. The Choir will sing part of the program for the patients at Gravelly Sanatorium next week.

The association meets in New York City Friday and Saturday. Dr. Farmer is professor of Medicine at the UNC School of Medicine.

Said Thompson, "If everybody could have a little experience with TB there would never be any problem raising money for research and eradication."

Bill Friday, state Christmas Seal chairman, agreed. "Now I really understand what the statement, 'Every six minutes, every day, one American breaks down with TB,' means," he said.

Christmas Seals fight TB by supporting research and programs aimed at preventing TB, finding cases, and helping TB patients with their problems before, during, and after treatment, Friday explained.

Friday Pays Yule Visit To Gravelly TB Patients

President William C. Friday on a pre-Yule visit to Gravelly Sanatorium on the eve of the 1958 Christmas Seal Sale campaign in North Carolina called on Mrs. Lois Bishop of Raleigh, typical of the thousands of Tar Heels who have tuberculosis. Friday is chairman of the drive this year.

Mrs. Bishop knows what it means to be among the 90,000 Americans TB strikes each year regardless of age, sex, race or economic status.

A TB patient at Gravelly Sanatorium in Chapel Hill, Mrs. Bishop, age 30, was found to have TB by the Wake County Health Department in 1956.

Today, aided by modern treatment methods, most patients can be "cured" in a matter of months. Mrs. Bishop, however, was not so lucky. She has had drug therapy and one operation and still faces many more months of drug treat-

ment and probably another operation before her disease is expected to be controlled.

This, in itself, is a tough problem but Mrs. Bishop has other anxieties to overcome which threaten the effectiveness of her treatment. She finds it hard "not to worry" about her four young children who had to be placed in boarding homes.

The outlook for Mrs. Bishop's eventual recovery is good but she will not be able to "forget her TB" even after she returns to her family because there's no certain or permanent cure.

That having TB is a "life-time proposition" is well understood by W. E. Thompson, president of the Bank of Chapel Hill. He was a student at the University in 1917 when his TB was discovered. Since he has suffered two relapses — in 1924 and 1958.

Thompson is quick to point out that there are 1,750,000 ex-TB patients like himself who must take "special care of themselves" to avoid relapse. From this standpoint alone TB is a tremendous public health problem.

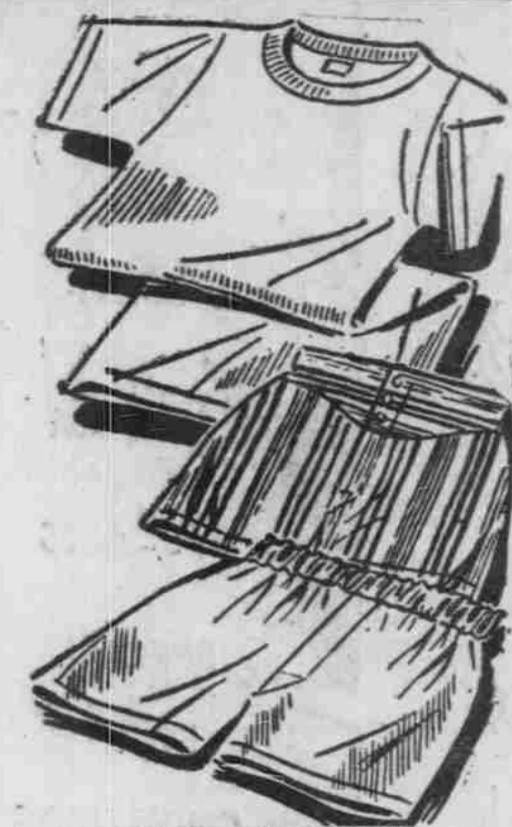

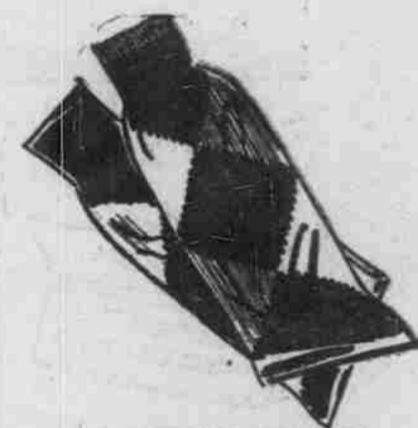

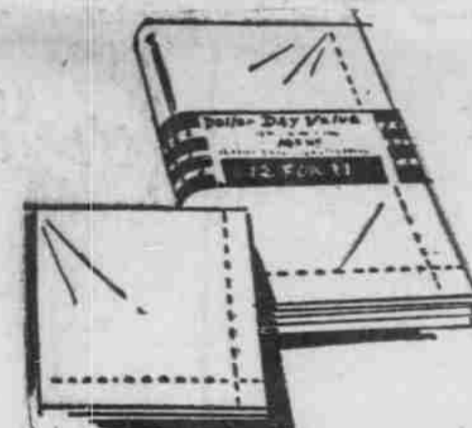
