Prestige Hangs By Many Threads

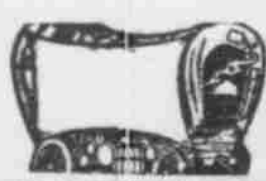
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Chemistry Researcher Elected To Honorary Scientific Fraternity

Feiss has had extensive experience in the field of city planning and urban renewal. From 1950 to 1954 he was with the Chief Planning and Engineering Branch, Di-

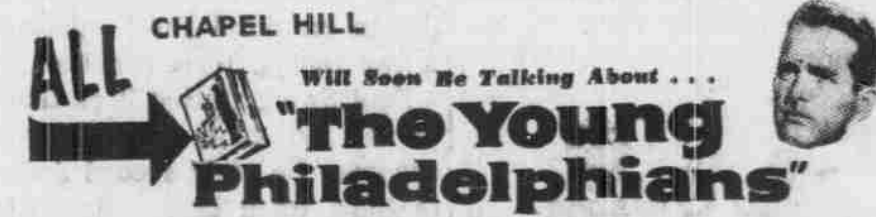

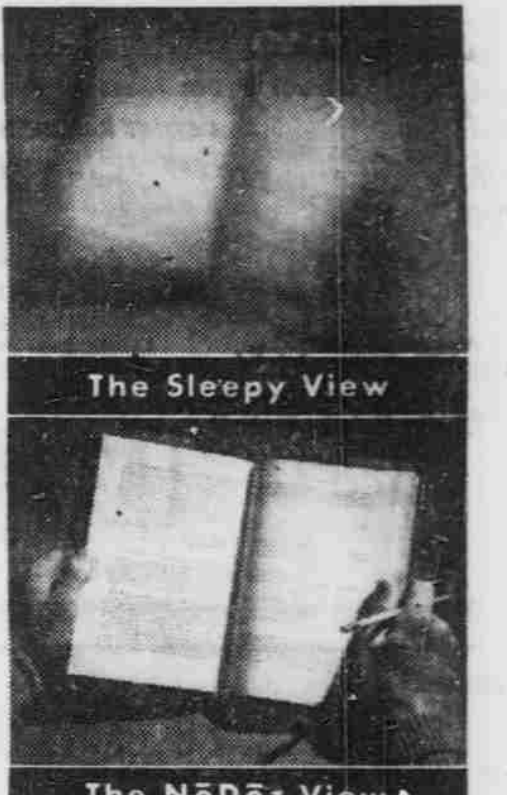
