This support is a giant step toward the realization of the University's main goal — maintaining its status as a great educational institution.

If there comes a time when we cannot say something good about a Carolina athlete, we prefer to say nothing at all. Despite its varied functions, the Daily Tar Heel is primarily a student newspaper. We will match them scholastically or extra-curricularly with any other segment of the campus and place a wager in their favor. Those who claim that their marks or accomplishments are due to their athletic prowess alone are merely inventing a feeble excuse for their own failures. Perhaps we know these boys too well. We are more concerned with keeping their weaknesses out of the paper than with putting them in. The college athlete deserves a respite from the glare of the public spotlight which is constantly focused on his private life.

The reader will notice that this column has been renamed 'On The Bench.' We will try to present Carolina athletics from the inside. Too often those on the outside make pitiful Monday morning quarterback. **Hawkins And Riggs Will Lead Tar Heels**

Rip Hawkins and Frank Riggs have been elected Co-Captains of North Carolina's 1960 football squad.

Hawkins, a 6-3, 220-pounder from Cowan, Tenn., has been a two-year regular at center. The 20-year-old youngster's defensive linebacking ability will make him a prime pro prospect at graduation. Last year he was the only Carolina player to be selected to the All ACC first team. He won honors as the Greensboro Daily News "Athlete of the Week" for his performance in the Wake Forest game.

The Ripper is a product of Sewanee Military Academy in Tennessee. There he was an All-Conference choice in both football and basketball. Hawkins will be a senior next year and is majoring in industrial relations. He is a member of Phi Gamma Delta fraternity and the social chairman of the Monogram Club. He is engaged to Miss Sara Arnold of Monroe, Ga. They will be married in June.

Frank Riggs, an All-American football and lacrosse star at Gilman Prep in Baltimore, entered Carolina in 1957.

During his freshman year he was a fullback. Spring drills, however, found him at an end spot. This was only the beginning of a number of switches. Fall practice
