**Alumnus Writes Best Seller**

A sensational new novelist of Europe whose books are being translated into English and predicted as best-sellers in the United States, largely because of "poly-saturation with sex," is a UNC alumnus—a foreign student on a Fulbright grant to study with the Carolina Playmakers nine years ago.

Agnar Mykle, the Norwegian author, was indignant that his second book was banned in his native country. He took his case to court and his appeal was successful. Charges of obscenity were overruled and Mykle is now writing the third of his trilogy.

When Mykle lived in Chapel Hill, he wrote plays and produced puppet shows. He is the latest international figure in the arts to have the Carolina Playmakers in his background. Mykle and his wife were here in 1951-52.

His first book, "Lasso Round the Moon" has been translated into English and is being promoted by E. P. Dutton and Co. in New York. More than 500,000 copies of his first two books have been sold in Scandinavia.

Other elected officers are: Pete Bondi, vice president; Joe Tosti, secretary; and Dave Harper, treasurer.

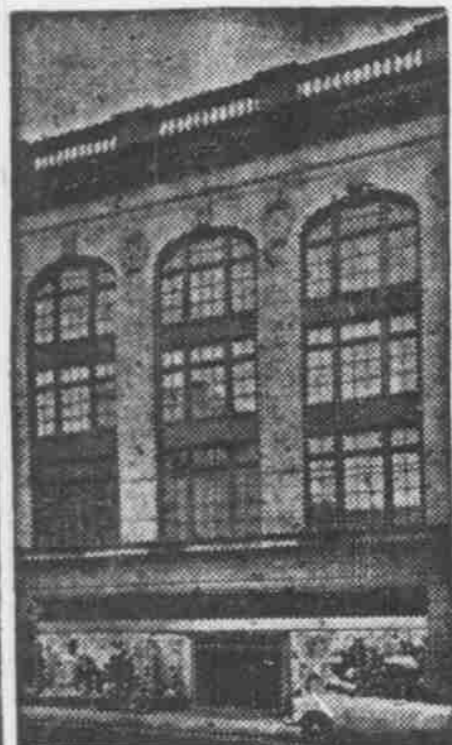
