

# Honorary Degrees Awarded To Five

UNC Monday night awarded honorary degrees to Dr. C. C. Crittenden, director of N. C. Archives; pharmacist; Thomas J. Pearsall, Roger A. McDuffie, Greensboro Rocky Mount attorney; Prof. Kenneth B. Raper, native North Carolinian who is a bacteriologist at the University of Wisconsin; and Dr. Joseph T. Wearn, native North Carolinian who is Dean of the School of Medicine at Western Reserve University in Cleveland, Ohio.

Degrees were awarded by Governor Terry Sanford and President William C. Friday.

Chancellor William B. Aycock presided at ceremonies in the Kenan Stadium in Chapel Hill.

Doctors of Law degrees were awarded to Crittenden, Pearsall and Wearn. Dr. Raper received the doctor of science degree, and McDuffie the doctor of pharmacy degree.

**CHRISTOPHER CRITTENDEN**, Director of the North Carolina Department of Archives and History, native of Wake Forest and graduate of Wake Forest College; Doctor of Philosophy of Yale University, and for ten years a member of the Department of History of this University, has brought to the position he held for a quarter of a century, a wealth of training and talent which have placed his department in the forefront of the nation . . .

**ROGER ATKINSON MCDUFFIE**, honor graduate in Pharmacy of this university in 1915, and for more than two score years respected member of the pharmaceutical profession in Greensboro, has epitomized in his career those qualities of selfless devotion to his profession and his fellowmen which are in the highest tradition of the healing arts . . .

**THOMAS JENKINS PEARSALL**, student of this university from 1923 to 1927, lawyer, legislator, business executive, philanthropist, and public-spirited citizen, has aided immeasurably in the recent growth and development of the University of North Carolina by his tireless

efforts and imaginative statesmanship as a member of the Board of Trustees since 1941 and of its Executive Committee since 1948 . . .

**KENNETH BRYAN RAPER**, native of North Carolina and graduate of this university in the class of 1929, Doctor of Philosophy of Harvard, and now Professor of Bacteriology at the University of Wisconsin, had the distinction of publishing, while still an undergraduate, an important contribution to scientific knowledge . . .

**JOSEPH TRELOAR WEARN**, Dean of the School of Medicine, and Vice President for Medical Affairs, Emeritus, of Western Reserve University; presently consultant to the School of Medicine of Western Reserve and of Harvard; North Carolinian by birth and heritage, graduate of Davidson College and of the Harvard Medical School, has brought special honor to his native state through his significant contributions to medical research and education . . .
