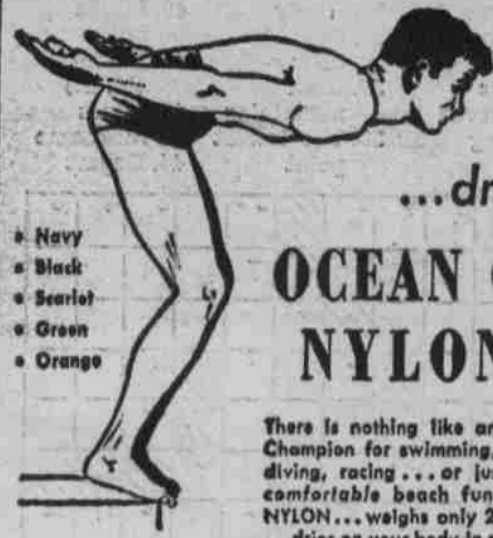
Former DTH Editor To Be Intern
