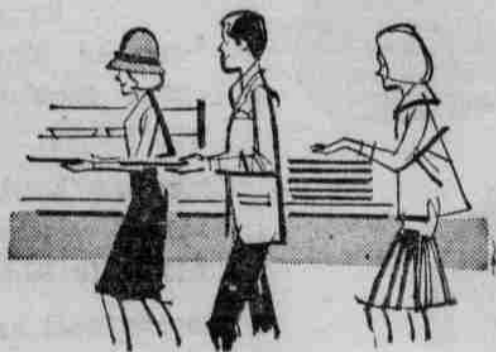

carrying as he picketed in front of Carswell's Colonial Drug Co. June 26.

Robert C. Russell's case was not pressed. Russell had been charged with engaging in an affray with Donald S. Long after a demonstration July 4. Long was found innocent of the charge two weeks ago.

Russell's attorney moved dismissal of the charge, pointing out "it takes two to make a fight, and the other boy was found innocent." Solicitor Roy M. Cole ob-

jected to dismissal of the case, but agreed to the nol pros.

A reckless driving charge, growing out of a desegregation demonstration July 6, will be tried tomorrow in Orange County Superior Court in Hillsboro.

Police lodged the charge against Harold Clark after he drove through the ranks of demonstrators while they were marching down Franklin Street.

dential appointment, Ellis indicated there are about 25 seats to be filled in various areas.

The Student Government Board, the legislative body governing students during the summer session, presently has three open seats, Ellis said.

The Men's and Women's Councils, which are responsible for trying students charged with alleged violations of the Honor and Campus Codes, have five vacancies each.

Ellis added that seven people are needed for the Men's Attorney General's Staff. This group investigates all alleged violations of the rules and turns over information to the appropriate judicial body.

There are also five positions open on the Summer School Secretariat staff, Ellis said. He noted that this group operates the SG office during the summer.
