White's father, who signed his son's bond, that the cases would be set for trial Oct. 13.

Carrboro attorney Barry Winston, retained as private investigator by Causey, asked for clarification of the situation in court Tuesday. He said he had been told by the Clerk of Court that the cases were to be tried Oct. 6, but that they were not listed on the docket.

Howard then told the court that the deputy who served the warrants had told Mr. White, Sr., that the trial date would be Oct. 13.

Because the bonds were returnable Tuesday, however, Judge L. J. Phipps gave instructions that the defendants be found and brought to court immediately. When they could not be found, the cases were called. Capiases for all three subsequently were issued, requiring their re-arrest and additional bonds.
