

Dean Takes Churchill Scholarship

Nathan W. Dean of Durham, second year graduate student in physics, has been awarded the Churchill Scholarship for a year's study at Cambridge University, England.

Dean was one of 10 chosen from 20 American universities

participating in the program. This is the first year that UNC has nominated a student for the scholarship.

Dean will attend Churchill College, named after the late Sir Winston Churchill, to study field theory.

A native of Johnson City, Tenn., Dean received his B.S. in physics from UNC in 1963.

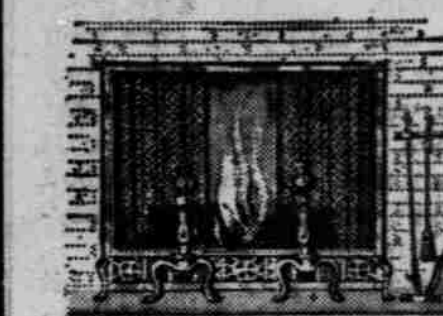
