Wales Wins Award

Heathote W. Wales, UNC senior from Loudonville, N.Y., has been named one of eight national winners of a \$1,500 Chi Psi Educational Trust graduate fellowship for the coming year.

The Morehead scholar, who plans to study law at either Harvard or Chicago in preparation for a career in politics, has been chairman of the Men's Honor Council, chairman of the Constitutional Council, associate editor of the DTH and has been active in NSA and State Student Legislature.

Last year Wales, who has recently been tapped into Phi Beta Kappa, was awarded a \$500 undergraduate scholarship by the Chi Psi Educational Trust.

Wales is the third North Carolina Chi Psi to win a graduate fellowship from the national educational trust in the ten years of the fellowship program.

This is the oldest and largest educational foundation in the national fraternity world, having made more than 80 fellowship grants totaling more than \$100,000 in the past decade.
