Poet Field To Read Here

Edward Field, whose book of poems, "Stand Up, Friend, With Me," won the Lamont Poetry prize in 1962, will read from his poems Friday at 7:30 p.m. in Gerrard Hall.

Field appears as the spring lecturer on the North Carolina Poetry Circuit. The gathering is open to the public, free of charge. Following the reading, coffee, tea and cookies will be served.

In selection of the Lamont Prize winner, presses submit their books of poetry and a board of poets picks the winner.

Born in Brooklyn, N. Y., in 1924, Field began writing poetry while serving with the Air Force in Europe during World War II. His poems have been published in such journals as Kenyon Review, Partisan Review and Harper's.

Thomas Lask of the New York Times says Field "possesses a tantalizing off-center view of the world. His gloss on the Book of Ruth would make the hairs of the rabbis stand up in horror. At their best, language and experience

are cut back to the core to reveal the unadorned thing in itself."

In the Christian Science Monitor, Webster Schott says "He is an authentic discovery. The clap-clap of regular rhyme and foot find no place in his work. It is the extraordinary tone — that draws one to Mr. Field's work. Mr. Field sees life whole . . . and in his vision it is filled with possibilities. Edward Field writes like a man possessed by a gift."

as the normal sports coverage," he said. There would be no commercials on the campus radio.

Initial costs will come to \$23,300, which includes all carrier current equipment. There will be an additional annual operating expense of \$11,628. This includes rentals for a UPI news wire, records, secretarial staff salaries, program director and station manager salaries and maintenance.

Programming will be oriented to the student. There would possibly be "oldie-goldie" radio show as well as classical, jazz and regular "Top 40" rock 'n' roll programs.

Stupak said that every dormitory will be provided with a carrier current transmitter, and that the fraternity courts have indicated they will participate.

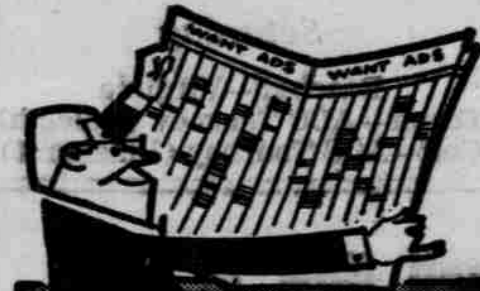
Stupak said that although some fraternities and sororities would not be included in the carrier current system they may be able to arrange a system for the others on a joint-costs basis.

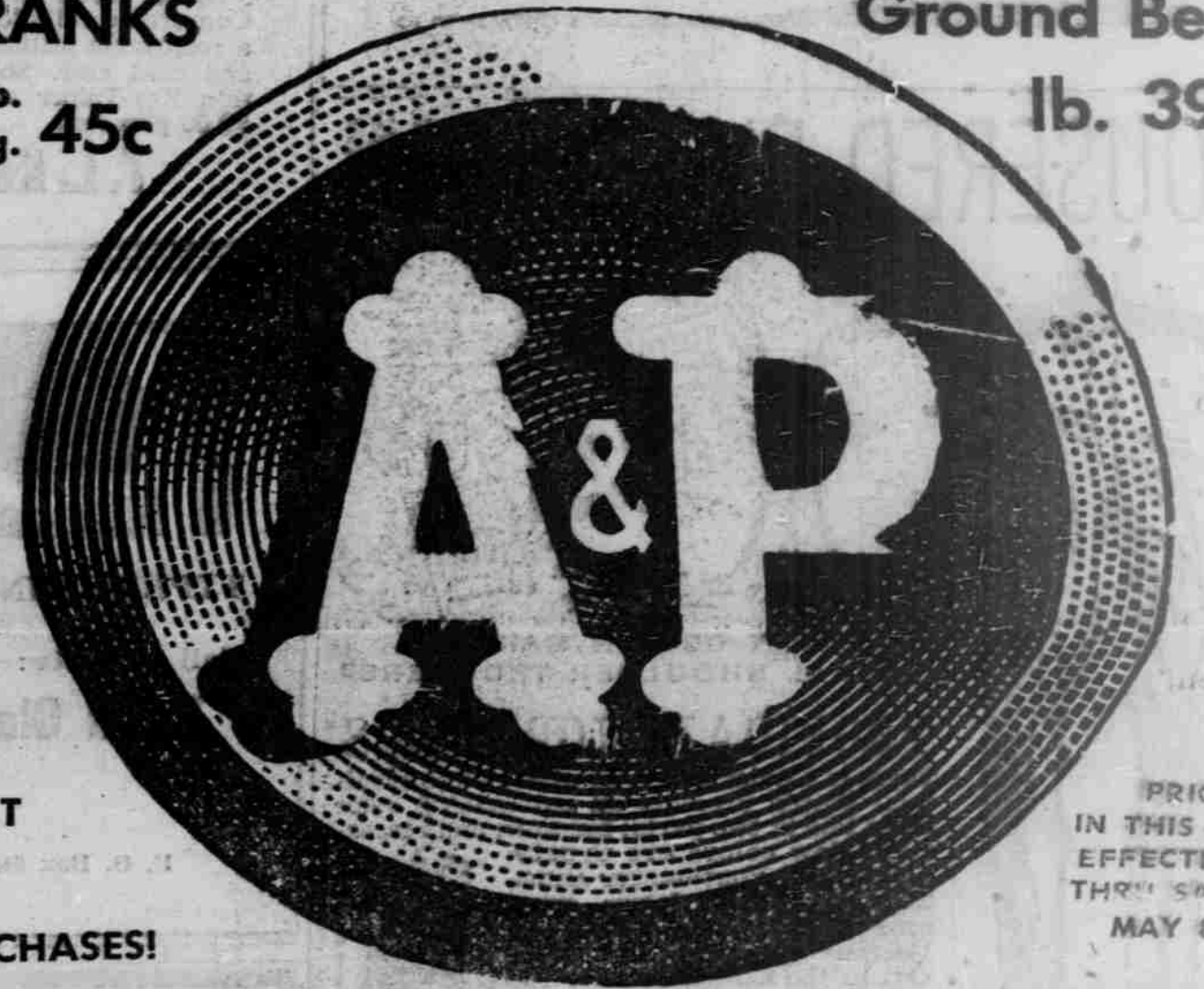

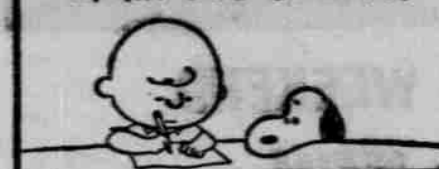
