Doyle To Discuss Church

FOCUS '67, the faculty-graduate lecture series on Christianity in the twentieth century, opens its spring semester program with a presentation entitled "Reason and the Charismatic in the Contemporary Church."

Questions related to the character and validity of such phenomenon as healing, prophecy, "speaking in tongues," and other such charismatic manifestations which have recently received nationwide publicity will be of central interest.

The featured speaker will be the Reverend Peter Doyle, Rector of St. James Episcopal Church in Leesburg, Va. A graduate of Washington and Lee University, Rev. Doyle received his theological training at Seabury-Western Theological Seminary in Evanston, Ill., after which he served as Professor of Theology at Cutting-

ton College Divinity School, Liberia, West Africa. From 1960-1963, he was engaged in doctoral studies under Karl Barth at the University of Basel.

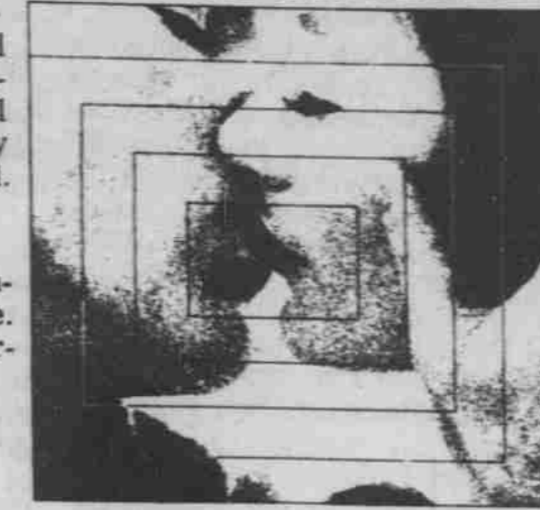
