Notary interviews today

Student Government will be holding
interviews today and Thursday to select a
UNC student to serve as a notary public
to notarize absentee ballots.

The interviews will be held from 1 to 3
p.m. in Suite C.

In order for a student to be considered
for the position, he must be a registered
voter in Orange County and must be
willing to work from April 7 through May

2 during the following hours: Monday
through Fridays, 2-5 p.m., and Monday
through Thursday, 7-9 p.m.

The position will pay \$1.60 per hour,
plus \$20 will be reimbursed for becoming
a notary.

A person who is already a notary
anywhere in North Carolina is also
eligible to be appointed, regardless of
where he is registered to vote.

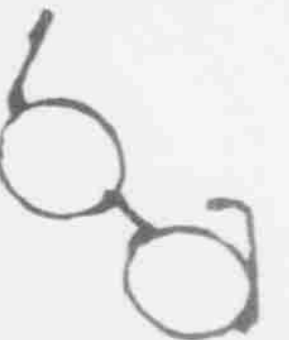

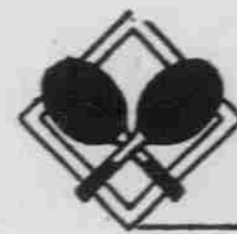
