Non-resident tuition concerns Holmes

Edward S. Holmes, Democratic candidate for the N.C. House of Representatives, told the DTH the out-of-state tuition at UNC should not be so high as to "discourage qualified students from outside North Carolina from attending.

"In order for us to remain a great university and not just another college. we must aggressively seek qualified out-of-state students."

Holmes, a life-time resident of North Carolina and a 1958 graduate of UNC Law School, is a partner in the Pittsboro law firm of Barber, Holmes and Barber.

Holmes said the issues of his greatest concern are public education, prison reform, mental health programs and environmental programs.

On mental health, he said, "I'd like to see as many services in the mental health program on the local level as possible. The staffs at the clinic should be

adequate to provide outpatient assistance. in order to keep citizens confined in state hospitals for as short a time as possible.

"I think we need to do more work in areas of rehabilitation. We should expand the use of sheltered workshops which allow some mentally and physically retarded people to be employed, and make their lives more valuable to them and to society," he continued.

Holmes said the entire insurance industry should be revamped. "The discriminatory rates charged to safe, young drivers are unconscionable. These drivers are often discriminated against in that their rates are sometimes higher than older drunk drivers."

On public education, Holmes stressed the need for smaller classrooms. "I'm extremely interested in seeing the student-teacher ratio lowered in order that a teacher might work with a small enough group to motivate them, to know them as individuals and to aid the children in knowing each other."

On the environment, he said, "I would

be very interested in seeing the proper zoning of estuary areas protected and all of our national resources protected. We should consider state control of unique environmental areas such as Bald Head Island."

Holmes also said he approved local voting registration of resident college students. "The earlier we learn citizenship and practice it, the better the community will be," he said.

"If we're going to improve services in which the people are interested, we're going to have to increase taxes," the candidate said in a DTH interview.

Cates, now serving his third term as mayor of Hillsborough, expressed his belief that people will be willing to pay more taxes if they receive the services for which they are paying.

"We need to use a graduated income tax system which puts the burden on the people who can pay," he contended.

"Many people are now making detrimental remarks about mental health, insurance and other services, and they are partly right."

But North Carolina still ranks high in mental health and prison reform when its services are compared with those in other states, Cates said.

As long as inmates live in crowded conditions and in dormitories within prisons, even a system of excellent programs for prisons will not be successful, Cates said. He called for adequate housing in individual cells for all prisoners in the state.

Cates, who served on the N.C. Prison Commission from 1965-67, asserted, "One of the worst things that can happen to a person in North Carolina is to be sent to prison."

Prison conditions often force prisoners who have only committed minor offenses to attempt escapes and as a result, to
