

rentals began, Thomas estimated between 110 and 130 units have been "lost."

Thomas explained there are no electrical restrictions on refrigerators in dorm rooms; however, there are restrictions on the total amount of wattage consumed by each room.

In category B dormitories, of which few remain, the wattage limit is 600 watts. Category A dormitories have a 1,200-watt limit.

Students can use the watt limit in any way it is desired. "If a student in an A dorm has a 1,000 watt refrigerator and one light bulb in his room, that's fine," said Thomas.

Thomas feels certain there will not be enough refrigerators for the demand, even though 360 new refrigerators have been added to the old ones.
