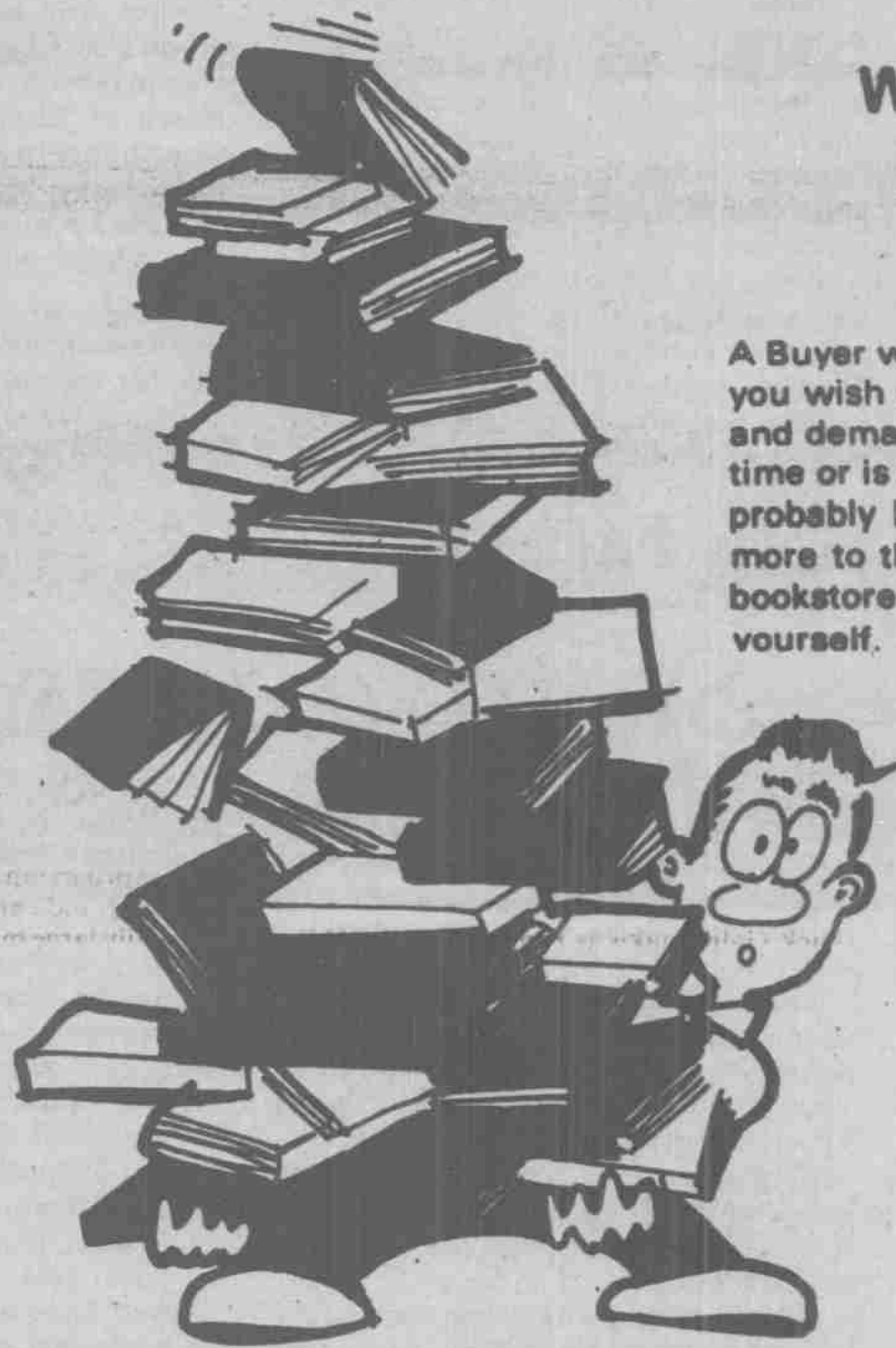

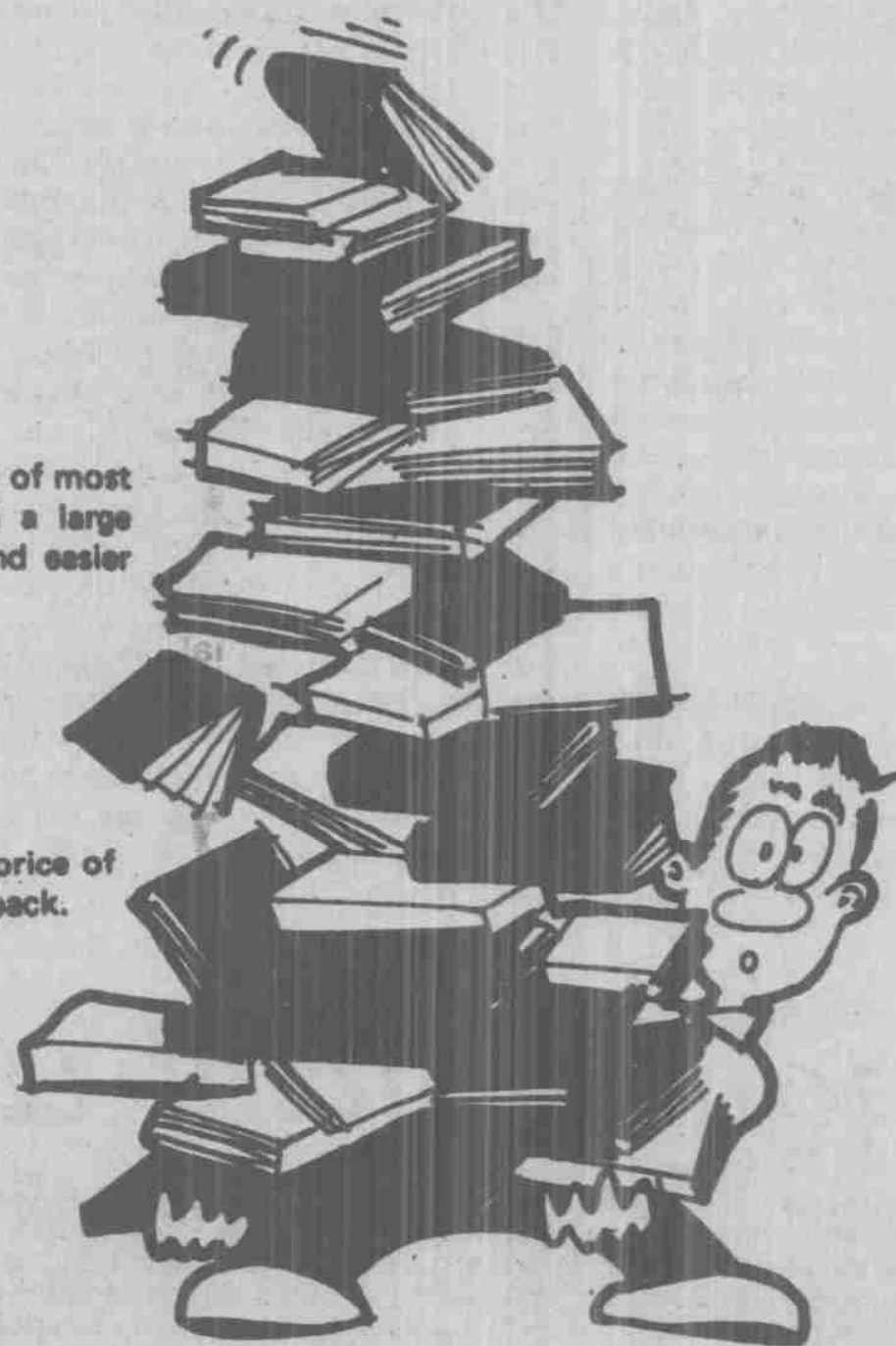


WHAT DO OTHER BOOKSTORES DO?
