# Preyer-Cloaninger wins doubles

Jane Preyer and Nina Cloaninger won the doubles title over Duke's Cindy Johnson and Erin Wolf 2-6, 6-3, 6-2 in the AIAW Region II Tennis Championships in Chattanooga, Tenn., last weekend.

Susie Black advanced to the third round in singles. Preyer finished fifth overall in singles and lost to Cindy Brinker of Virginia 7-5, 6-3. Cloaninger lost to Brinker in three sets.

Preyer, Cloaninger and Black will participate in the AIAW National Championships at the University of Utah in Salt Lake City June 14.

The UNC men's golf team finished third in a field of 25 teams, several of which were ranked among the top 20 in the nation, in the Southern Intercollegiate Golf Tournament at Athens, Ga. UNC has not been selected to participate

in the NCAA Championships in Albuquerque, New Mexico, next weekend, and UNC Coach Mike McLeod thinks that his team's good finish will prove to the selection committee that they were wrong.

"It was a good way to wind up the season," McLeod said.

Chip Beck of Georgia won individual honors in the tournament with a three-round score of 209. Freshman Kevin King was the leader for UNC with a three-round score of 217. King finished seventh in the tournament. Sophomore John Elam finished with a score of 220; Bill Buttner, 220; Bill Sibbick, 222; and John McGough, 226.

Gary Hofsetter, mile and two-mile state champion from Pittsburgh, Pa., has signed a track grant-in-aid with the Tar Heels.

Hofsetter ran for North Allegheny High School last year. He has the leading times in Pennsylvania in both events this season.

He was also named the number one runner in his district of the Western Pennsylvania Athletic League the past two years.

Joe Hilton, UNC track coach, said, "We are very pleased that Gary made UNC his choice for his studies and collegiate competition. He's a fine student and leader, and we consider Gary to be an outstanding prospect."
