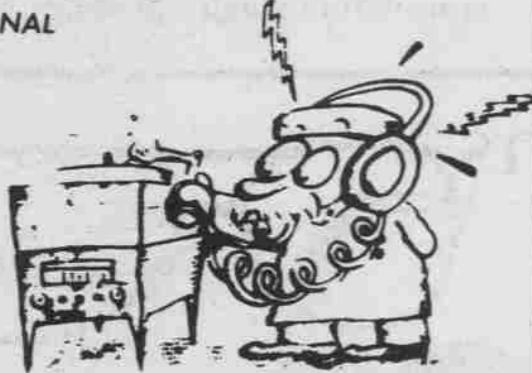

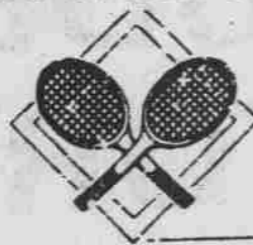

5-4 vote decides Graphics' future; months of debate are now over

Moss was Media Board chairperson last fall.

An MBA study made last spring by business student Greg Kapfer at the request of the Media Board has also been used to support the Board's resolution.

In the study, Kapfer said, "Student Graphics as now organized, is not economically viable. However, it may be made viable, with the brunt of the work falling on the board of directors. I

believe management is willing to work to improve operations...but management needs support from the CGC and direction from the Board of directors.

He suggests a six-point remedial program for Graphics.

Commenting on the report, Moss said, "Steve did quite a bit to turn around Graphics. However, Kapfer's report says Graphics is not viable..."

"I had nothing against Graphics; I'm trying to look out for the student body as a whole. I want to facilitate whatever the Media Board agrees with," he said.

The meeting Tuesday began with a slide show presentation to the Board by William LaPier, manager of UPD. The slide show displayed the facilities and services available at UPD.

After the slide show, the Board debated the various merits of Graphics compared to UPD. Gould, who is the chairman of the Board of Directors, directed the discussion back to approval of the budget.

After discussion ended, Gould cast the deciding vote in favor of accepting the budget for the coming year. As soon as the budget was accepted, the Board began discussing the motion to dissolve the corporation.

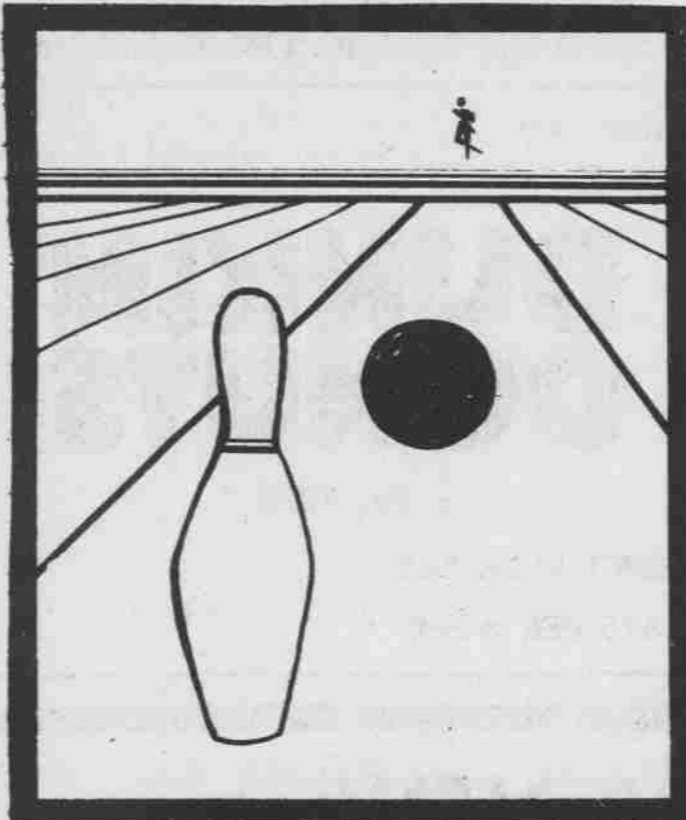
