## Advent tradition to be followed in church service

A procession of lessons and carols for Advent, patterned after the traditional English ceremony at King's College, Cambridge, will take place at identical 9:15 and 11:15 a.m. Sunday services at the Chapel of the Cross, 304 E. Franklin St.

Organist-Choirmaster Wylie S. Quinn, III will direct the combined senior and children's choirs of the Chapel of the Cross in singing music by the 17th-century composer Thomas Ravenscroft as well as 20th-century songs by Boris Ord, Benjamin Britten and William Walton.

Lessons from the old testament prophets and gospel accounts of Christ's coming will be read by children and adults of the parish. Child care will be provided, and refreshments will be served after each service in the parish house.
