Places, said Peter Kaplan, preservation planner with the archives division.

Carrboro already has three buildings on the National Register. They are Carr Mill, The Station and the Johnson-Strowd-Ward warehouse, which used to be a grist mill.

To be listed on the National Register, a building must have local, state, regional or national historical or architectural significance. It must have distinctive qualities of design (it may typify a trend, for example), and some type of historical association.

National Register buildings must also have design integrity, meaning that architecturally historical features must

by federal-or state-funded projects.

Though this protection is not absolute, Kaplan said that National Register distinction activates a review process that must take place before potentially destructive projects can pro-

National Register distinction does not control what a property owner can do, Kaplan said. But those who rehabilitate income-producing property on the National Register in accordance with specific guidelines may obtain favorable income tax advantages.

Kaplan said that the inventory could also be used to identify buildings in Carrboro that may be eligible for benefits from the 10 percent federal investment tax credit.

A building does not have to be on the National Register and cannot be a residence or rental property.

Claudia Roberts, chairperson of the historic preservation subcommittee of

the Carrboro Appearance Commission, said that the main purpose of the inventory is to get people interested in the preservation of Carrboro's historic resources. She said the rapid growth of Carrboro might otherwise endanger some of the other buildings in the area



## **News In Brief**

### UNC desegregation hearings resume

After a four-month delay, UNC and the state of North Carolina present the defense of their efforts to integrate the UNC system in desegregation hearings with the U.S. Department of Education today.

The Department of Education, which is trying to cut off about \$90 million in federal funds to UNC for allegedly failing to integrate its campuses, presented its arguments from July to October. Richard Robinson, assistant to UNC President William Friday, said defense testimony would take about two months to complete.

UNC officials contend they have complied with all civil rights laws and are substantially improving the five predominantly black institutions of the UNC system. Department of Education officials said in their arguments that while blacks comprise 22 percent of the state's population, they make up less than 8 percent of the students at the historically white campuses, of which UNC-CH

After Administrative Law Judge John Mathias decides whether UNC's integration efforts have been adequate, Education Secretary Terrell Bell will decide whether funds will be suspended. Bell was appointed by President Ronald Reagan, who advocates decreased federal interference in state activities, including education.
