Employment service to operate second session

A service to help UNC students find part-time jobs both on and off campus will begin operating about July 12. Student Body President Mike Vandenberg said this week.

The Student Employment Service will coordinate local job openings with students' job requests, Vandenberg said. Local businesses may list job openings with the service

and employment service volunteers will contact student applicants to tell them about the openings. "The rest is up to the student," he said.

Phil Armstrong, director of the employment service for the summer, said he had asked the Chapel Hill/Carrboro Chamber of Commerce to encourage local businesses to list job openings with the service.

Not all students will be eligible to apply

for jobs through the Student Employment Service. Students on financial aid, for example, could lose some of their grant money were they to get a job.


The ineligibility is "really true of any kind of employment," said Mary Garren, assistant director for unemployment at UNC's Financial Aid Office. "We have awarded them (money), then if they come up and get a job after the fact they may have to repay part of their grant."

Vandenberg said the financial aid office would be sent a copy of every application for employment and would check to see if the student applying was eligible to get a job without losing financial aid funds.

Although the Student Employment Service will be staffed entirely by volunteers, it will present a substantial cost to Student Government, Vandenberg said. Most of the costs will be brought on by setting up the office and printing up applications and brochures, he said.

Vandenberg said he planned to spend about a third of his \$2,200 Executive Budget on the employment service. He may ask the Campus Governing Council to fund the service this fall, he added.

The Student Employment Service will be located in Suite B of the Carolina Union and will operate from 1-4 p.m. Monday through Thursday during summer school.
