

Premed/prevent advisory office provides counseling and information

In an effort to help students interested in health careers after graduation, the Premedical/Preventive Advising Office is revitalizing its advising program.

"It's not that the office hasn't been there, it's just that it hasn't been visible," said Robert Thorpe, assistant professor of medical allied health professions and faculty coordinator of the Premed/Pre-

dent Advising Office.

Besides conducting workshops about medical schools, the graduate intern who works in the office now draws up a computer profile on the type of students medical schools are seeking, Thorpe said.

There is also a student advisory staff consisting of seniors who have been accepted at medical schools. The student advisers are able to offer first-hand information to those interested in health careers, Thorpe said.

A pre-veterinary student adviser has been added as part of the student advisory staff this year so that students may gain information about veterinary schools, Thorpe said.

The advising office is also sending an information sheet about various health programs to the Office of Undergraduate Admissions to mail to students who have inquired about a particular health field, Thorpe said.

The advising office will participate in Tar Heel Days during the summer in order to inform incoming students about the health programs offered at UNC, Thorpe said.

There are also plans to have a booklet "PreMed PreMed Preview Review" ready for print by this summer, Thorpe said. This booklet will contain information concerning college careers in the various health fields, he said.

Thorpe said the advising office plans to recruit a student adviser from the department of Medical Allied Health Professions in order to assist students interested in this area of study.

As a part of its revitalization, the advising office is holding open house today from 11 a.m. until 4 p.m., in its office in 201D Steele Building.

WASHINGTON — President Reagan sent the Soviet Union on Tuesday a scaled-down proposal that would first reduce, rather than eliminate, the arsenals of medium-range nuclear missiles in Europe. But the Kremlin's chief negotiator said "I'm not optimistic."

The proposal leaves room for the United States to install new cruise and Pershing II missiles on the continent late this year, while requiring the Soviets to tear down some of theirs. Reagan declined to discuss the specifics, but he said, "We've never retreated" from the decontamination plan.

TEGUCIGALPA, Honduras — Honduras claimed Tuesday that its army intercepted Nicaraguan troops smuggling weapons to the leftist guerrillas in El Salvador. From the other side of Central America's newest war, Nicaragua charged that Honduras troops attacked two Nicaraguan border posts.

There also were more reports of sporadic fighting in northern Nicaragua between Nicaraguan troops and anti-Sandinista exiles based in Honduras. The exiles claimed to have killed 20 Nicaraguans in an ambush.
