Orange Co. Crisis Center aids rape victims

Rape victims in Chapel Hill can expect to receive gentle and sensitive treatment because of Orange County's model system for dealing with rape cases, according to Mary Ann Chap, director of the Orange County Rape Crisis Center.

Orange and Chatham counties have such effective systems for dealing with rape cases that the N.C. Council on the Status of Women is developing a procedure for handling rape cases based on the programs in those two counties. The council attempts to help medical personnel and law enforcement officials understand how to deal with rape victims.

According to Chap, an effective system takes constant maintenance and is often hard to initiate. "The problem is that there is no consistency throughout the state," she

blem. According to Chap, who attended a conference sponsored by the council, the council has a statewide communication line. The council is under the Department of Administration and works with the Justice Academy, which trains law officers in the state, Chap said. Chap said that she thought that the council was respected in the state.

Chap said the system in Orange County worked because of cooperation between the crisis center, the police departments and hospital staffs.

A woman who has been assaulted sometimes calls the crisis center even before she seeks medical or legal help, and the center will immediately offer her information on law enforcement and medical procedures, Chap said. The center encourages the victim to seek both types of help, she added.


The center provides the victim with a companion who will counsel her and accompany her to the police station as well as to the emergency room. "Support, companionship, and referral are our most important functions,"

Three of the companions are male and do not work directly with rape victims, unless the victims are male. The three male companions usually work with husbands or boyfriends of the victims in order to help them understand what the victim is going through. Ages of the companions vary, said Chap. One of the male companions is a law student, and another has a 16-year-old

Companions are screened first, and afterward they receive 20 to 24 hours of extensive training, Chap said. After the training, another screening takes place, and the companion signs a six-month written contract. Companions are also required to attend about two companion meetings a month, Chap said.

The center itself handles about 60 to 70 cases a year, Chap said. Ages of the victims have ranged from a 7-year-old girl to a woman in her nineties, Chap said. The greatest number of victims is between the ages of 19 and 25, according to Chap. This figure is consistent with







MOUNTAIN VIEW. Calif. -Pioneer 10, the "ultimate time capsule" crossed Pluto's orbit 3.5 billion miles from Earth on Monday and sped on its endless journey through the Milky Way galaxy. Scientists hailed the event as a "proud day in America."

The spacecraft with a "simple, straightforward design" has outlasted its intended 21-month life by nearly a decade and scientists now predict that the craft, built for \$20 million and launched March 2, 1972, will outlive the solar system.

"Some five billion years from now, our sun will self-destruct," said Dr. Joseph Wampler of the Lick Observatory at the University of California at Santa Cruz. "This spacecraft has escape the solar system."

Wampler said Pioneer 10 "will live in interstellar space 100 billion years."

"For me, that is an eternity," he said. "In that time, our entire universe will evolve into something quite different."

WASHINGTON - The Supreme Court said Monday it will decide whether immigration agents may sweep through factories in search of illegal aliens while fellow agents block the

The court will review a ruling that banned such tactics in nine Western states - including California and Arizona, where thousands of illegal aliens reside.

A federal appeals court ruled that such raids, that have led to the arrests of tens of thousands of people, are unconstitutional because they detain everyone in the factories.

In the illegal aliens case, agents of the federal Immigation and Naturalization Service conducted three "surveys" of two Los Angeles area garment factories

In two such sweeps of the Southern California Davis Pleating Co., agents arrested 117 illegal alients.
