BEIRUT, Lebanon — Druze shells hit Christian east Beirut on Monday, the Lebanese army fired at militiamen in nearby mountains and U.S. jets roared over central Lebanon.

In Israeli-occupied southern Lebanon, Israeli troops guarding the Awali River bridge shot and killed an unidentified man who tried to lob a grenade at them, the military command in Tel Aviv said. Earlier, a roadside bomb slightly wounded two Israeli soldiers as their vehicle traveled east of Tyre, the command said. It did not elaborate.

As the largely ignored Lebanese civil-war truce entered its eighth week, the new U.S. special Middle East envoy Donald Rumsfeld conferred with President Amin Gemayel and top aides in Beirut.

WASHINGTON — President Reagan pronounced his visit to Japan and South Korea a success Monday, saying that "America's partnerships are stronger and prospects for a more secure peace and prosperity are better today than a week ago."

Nearly 16 hours after he was cheered by an estimated 2 million flag-waving people in Seoul as he rode to the airport, Reagan arrived by helicopter on the White House South Lawn to a welcome by Vice President and Mrs. George Bush, a military band and about 200 government employees who waved small American flags.

RALEIGH — A major state race-relations group, fearing that close political races in 1984 could stir racial emotions, has urged candidates not to use racially divisive tactics.

The 20-member N.C. Human Relations Council in a statement last week urged "candidates for local and statewide office to conduct campaigns that address specific issues in an effort to promote goodwill and reduce the rising polarization among the citizens of the state."
