Winston Winston-Salem Symphony, will be on the
podium to direct the orchestra. Famed podium to direct the orchestra. Famed
violinist Eugene Fodor will perform as guest soloist.
Fodor began his musical studies at an
early age and made his debut with the early age and made his debut with the
Denver Symphony at age e 10 . its teachers have included Jascha Heifetz and Mischa
Mischakof. Fodor has taken first prize awards in the International Paganini Compertition,
the Merriweather-Post Competition and the Merriweather-Post Competition and the Young Musicians Foundation Na-
tional Competition. In 1974, Fodor won the Silver Medal, the highest award ever given to an American musician, in
Moscow's Tchaikovsky Competition. No Gold Medal was given that year. With the N.C. Symphony, Fodor will
perform one of the staples of the violin perform one of the staples of the violin
repertoire, Johannes Brahms' Violin Concerto in D Major. Violin Brahms composed the violin concerto,
