Senate approves aid for anti-Sandinista guerrillas

WASHINGTON — By a 76-19 vote, the Senate Thursday approved \$61.7 million in emergency aid for El Salvador and \$21 million for anti-Sandinista guerrillas in Nicaragua. The aid provoked strong opinions in the Senate with Sen. Edward M. Kennedy, D-Mass. saying, "The Senate has voted for wider war in El

Salvador, secret war in Nicaragua and the brink of war in Honduras." Sen. John East, R-N.C., challenged Kennedy's statement saying, "We are niggling and nitpicking and nipping at the heels of anything that seems to offer

serious resistance to the expansion of Soviet power in our hemisphere." The bill now goes to the Democrat-controlled House which will have only three working days to consider it before beginning a 10-day Easter recess next week.
