

# Veteran lectures on Vietnam War

American involvement in El Salvador cannot be criticized solely on the basis of the outcome of the Vietnam War, Tim Lomparis, a political science professor at Duke University, said in a lecture Wednesday on the "Legacy of Vietnam."

"You don't draw lessons from a conclusion," Lomparis said. Components of an experience are more crucial to understand, he told about 20 students in the Carolina Union. "If we are to draw

lessons from Vietnam we certainly need to focus on the entire performance."

When attempting to evaluate the situation in El Salvador, people are looking for a universal package of lessons within one war, Lomparis said. He said it was important to take a serious look at other western power interventions that have had different results. Cambodia, the communist experience in China, and communist guerilla activity in Greece are examples he cited.

Lomparis said he would like to see a coalition government set up in El Salvador. This would "splinter the left wide apart," he said. He described a

coalition in El Salvador resulting in a socialist government as "an outcome we all could live with."

Unlike El Salvador, Vietnam did not have enough forces behind it to establish a coalition government, he said.

American involvement in civil revolutions is a "damned if you do and damned if you don't" situation. "Nobody is allowed any more to have a civil revolution in peace," Lomparis said.

The Campus-Y Global Issues Committee sponsored Lomparis' lecture. Lomparis, author of *The War Everybody Lost and Won*, is a veteran of the Vietnam War.

# Senate condemns mining of ports

WASHINGTON — The Reagan administration, feeling the heat from an 84-12 Senate vote condemning the mining of Nicaraguan ports, may not resume the mining operation, an administration spokesman said Wednesday.

The State Department official, who spoke on the condition that he not be identified, said the initial phase of the mining was completed before the Senate condemned the operation in a Tuesday night vote. He also said the CIA would be forced to halt the operation if the House of Representatives votes down

the \$21 million approved by the Senate to aid "contra" rebels in Nicaragua.

The anti-mining resolution was sponsored by Sen. Edward Kennedy, D-Mass., and was supported by Majority Leader Howard Baker, R-Tenn.

### Satellite repaired in orbit

CAPE CANAVERAL, Fla. — Two astronauts broke the world's record for

spacewalking as they made the first in-space repairs on a satellite.

Astronauts James van Hoften and George Nelson worked for seven hours and seven minutes on the Solar Max satellite, replacing malfunctioning electronic equipment that had rendered the satellite non-operational only months after its February 1980 launch.

MOSCOW — A triumphant Konstantin Chernenko officially became the Soviet Union's 10th president Wednesday, giving him the top three leadership posts and a stature equal to that of his two predecessors.
