dent department.

"The chancellor or someone should run shotgun on the athletic department so that it has a responsibility to the University," Terrell said.

Yet Chancellor Christopher C, Fordham III said he already had enough control of the athletic department and the Rams Club through his contact with Athletic Director John Swofford.

"Mr. Swofford is someone I appointed to a post," Fordham said. "Before he undertakes any policies or programs he consults with me, and he clearly reports to this office and keeps me informed of what's going on."

In addition, because University's foundations comply with the wishes of their respective department heads,

Fordham said ne nad indirect control over the Rams Club through Swofford.

Swofford said he agreed the University was exercising sufficient and appropriate control over athletics and the Rams Club. Some of the misperceptions arose after the Rams Club became involved in fundraising for the SAC, he said, because the Rams Club became more visible and because of the conflict about seating in the SAC

Student Body President Paul Parker agreed. "The Rams Club does have a lot of power as far as the SAC is concerned," he said. "But they're being played off as the bad guys when they're really only doing what the University asked them to do - to raise money for the building."

"People see it as big, kind of a secret, kind of like a monster." Parker said. "If you don't have a good grasp of what it is, you're going to have a fear of the unknown."

To help clear up misperceptions, the University needs a written, formalized policy of its relationship with the Rams Club, Parker said.

"If you do something that's general enough so that it doesn't limit anyone, yet lists the facts, I think that would help the problems of perceptions a lot," Parker said.




