

# Horton named conference's top player

## From Staff and Wire Reports

Ethan Horton, UNC's tailback whose transition from the quarterback position led him to fourth place among the school's rushers, has been selected Atlantic Coast Conference player of the year by The Associated Press.



honor. Georgia Tech quarterback John Dewberry and Maryland line-Ethan Horton backer Eric Wil-

son also received votes. Horton, from Kannapolis, was recruitd by UNC coach Dick Crum as

an all-state quarterback. When injuries struck Kelvin Bryant in 1981, Horton stepped in and rushed for 144 yards, including a clutch touchdown against Maryland. Both players returned to action, shared the responsibilities in the Gator Bowl and also shared MVP

When Bryant was re-injured in 1982, Horton came to the rescue again, rushing for 576 yards and seven touchdowns. He earned MVP honors when the Tar Heels downed Texas in the Sun

"When I first changed to tailback. I took the idea that I would never get to be a quarterback into consideration," Horton said. "I knew once I changed my mind, that was something I had to stick with."

Horton was still sharing time during his junior season with Tyrone Anthony. The results were just as productive -

both players rushed for more than 1,000 vards.

This season, Horton was the catalyst of the Tar Heel offense. He gained 1,247 yards on 238 carries and six touchdowns. He also hauled in three touchdown passes and threw one to quar-

terback Kevin Anthony. Horton thinks his senior year was the product of what he had learned from

Bryant as well as a natural ability. "I think one of the biggest things was trying to see the whole field," Horton said of Bryant's teachings."Basically, he told me to have my own style of running."

Aside from Horton's award, Virginia coach George Welsh was named ACC coach of the year by AP. Welsh received six of the seven votes cast by the panel after leading his Cavaliers to a 7-2-2 season and the first Virginia bowl appearance ever.


