Wallace

"I'm really stressing personal contact between Student Government members and other students," Wallace said. The Executive Branch is selling doughnuts this month to increase student involvement in her administration. Funds raised will go to the Executive Branch and the UNC-CH Drug and Alcohol Outreach Program. The counseling service, designed by brothers Thomas and Fetzter Mills, will open March 11. "As far as I'm concerned, anyone with a student I.D. is in Student Government," said Wallace, who hopes to have most of her appointed positions filled by Friday. "I'm looking for as diverse a group of people as I can get, with an emphasis on teamwork. Anyone with a project or an idea and the willingness to work on it should come talk to me." Another top priority for Wallace's administration is the UNITAS project.

tentatively planned for the fall of 1986. UNITAS participants would live in the same dormitory for a trial year and attend the same minority-relations course. Proponents of the project on the University Relations Committee hope to make UNITAS a permanent campus institution. Another priority for Wallace is the re-allocation of Union office space. Some organizations without offices may be given office assignments, and other office assignments may be relocated. Wallace is also urging the conversion of the space formerly occupied by the Fast Break into a student coffeehouse. Similar to the system employed by former Student Body President Paul Parker, Wallace will be using project-specific committees to accomplish many of her administration's goals. A committee has already been formed to research and develop the Drive-a-Drinker program, one of Wallace's major campaign issues. Drivers would be trained in first aid. The service would be staffed with student volunteers, but the insurance details still need to be worked out, Wallace said. Student Government is accepting applications for committee heads and members to address the following issues: Getting another van for handicapped students. Frequently students wait for van service up to 40 minutes, Wallace said. Helping students get jobs through the Student Part-Time Employment Service. Establishing an alcohol policy for student functions.

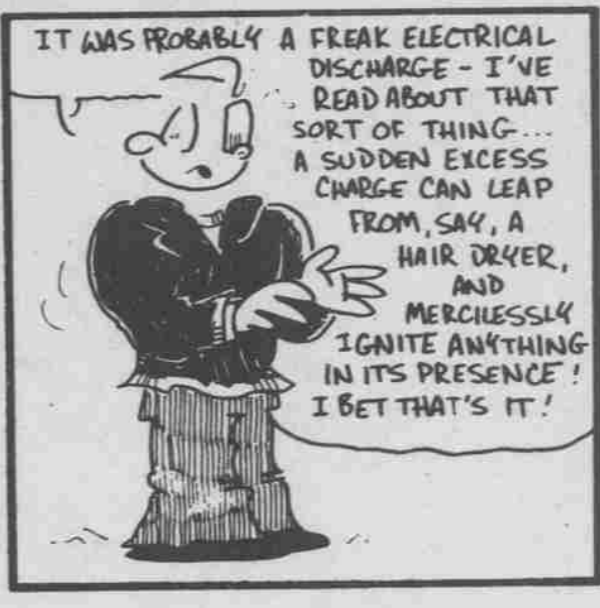

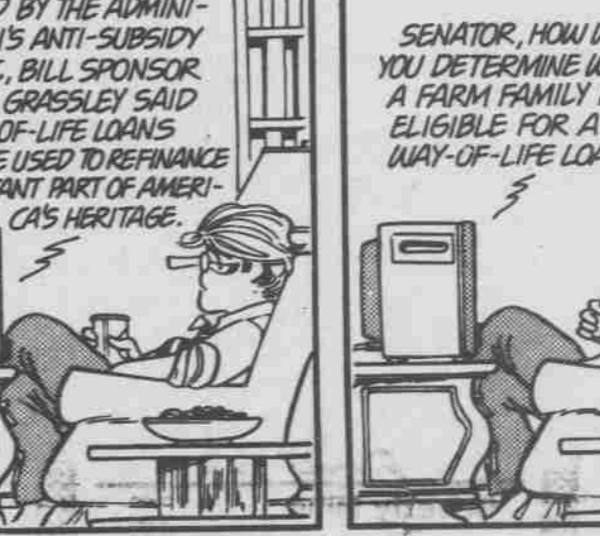
