declining minority enrollment in the face of rising college costs and reduc-

tions of federal student aid. Hackley said he doubted the traditionally white institutions would ever

meet the goal. "We'll have to look at enrollment figures throughout the nation and decide whether it is reasonable." Hackley said. "I don't think we can do much more than they're doing."

Hackley said heavy recruitment was a reason for the UNC system defying the national trend.

"The quicker we can get a child interested in college, the better," Hackley said. "Most states do not recruit until the 12th grade, then it's too late. We start at the seventh grade."

Another reason is the location of UNC system schools, he said. "Geographic access is fairly uniform across North Carolina," he said.

Among the traditionally white schools, significant increases in black enrollment came at East Carolina. which rose by 112 black students to 11.4 percent, and N.C. State, which rose by 199 black students to 8.8 percent.

The biggest increases in black students came at the traditionally black institutions, particularly at N.C. A&T and N.C. Central. Several traditionally white institu-

tions saw declines in black students this fall, including the N.C. School of the Arts, UNC-Asheville, UNC-Greensboro and Western Carolina.




